LAODICEA

- Wretched
- Miserable
- Poor
- Blind
- Naked



PERGAMUM

- Held fast Jesus Name
- Did not deny my faith (even when Antipas was killed)
- Courageous in the face of death
- However, Neutral vs Action





EPHESUS

- Active workers in the Kingdom
- They tested those who claimed to be apostles
- Persevered and refused to tolerate false teaching
- Did not lose heart during their tribulations
- However, they left their first love



- 40 miles north of Ephesus
- 2nd in size only to Ephesus
- One of the headquarters for the Concillia
- First City / Crown of Smyrna (Mt Pagos)







Revelation 2:8 "And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write, 'These things says the First and the Last, who was dead, and came to life:"

- Revelation 1:11 "saying, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last," and, "What you see, write in a book and send *it* to the seven churches which are in Asia: to Ephesus, to Smyrna, to Pergamos, to Thyatira, to Sardis, to Philadelphia, and to Laodicea.""
- Isaiah 41:4 "Who has performed and done *it*, Calling the generations from the beginning? 'I, the LORD, am the first; And with the last I *am* He.'"

- Proverbs 5:21 "For the ways of a man are before the eyes of the LORD, And He watches all his paths."
- Poverty (ptōcheia) means the condition of one destitute of riches and abundance, extreme or deep poverty
- Romans 2:28-29 "For he is not a Jew who [is one] outwardly, nor [is] circumcision that which [is] outward in the flesh; 29 but [he is] a Jew who [is one] inwardly; and circumcision [is that] of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise [is] not from men but from God."

- "Eighty and six years have I served Christ and He has done me nothing but good; how then could I curse Him, my Lord and Savior?" He was then burned alive
