Vs. 10- All thy works shall praise thee, O Lord; and thy saints shall bless thee.

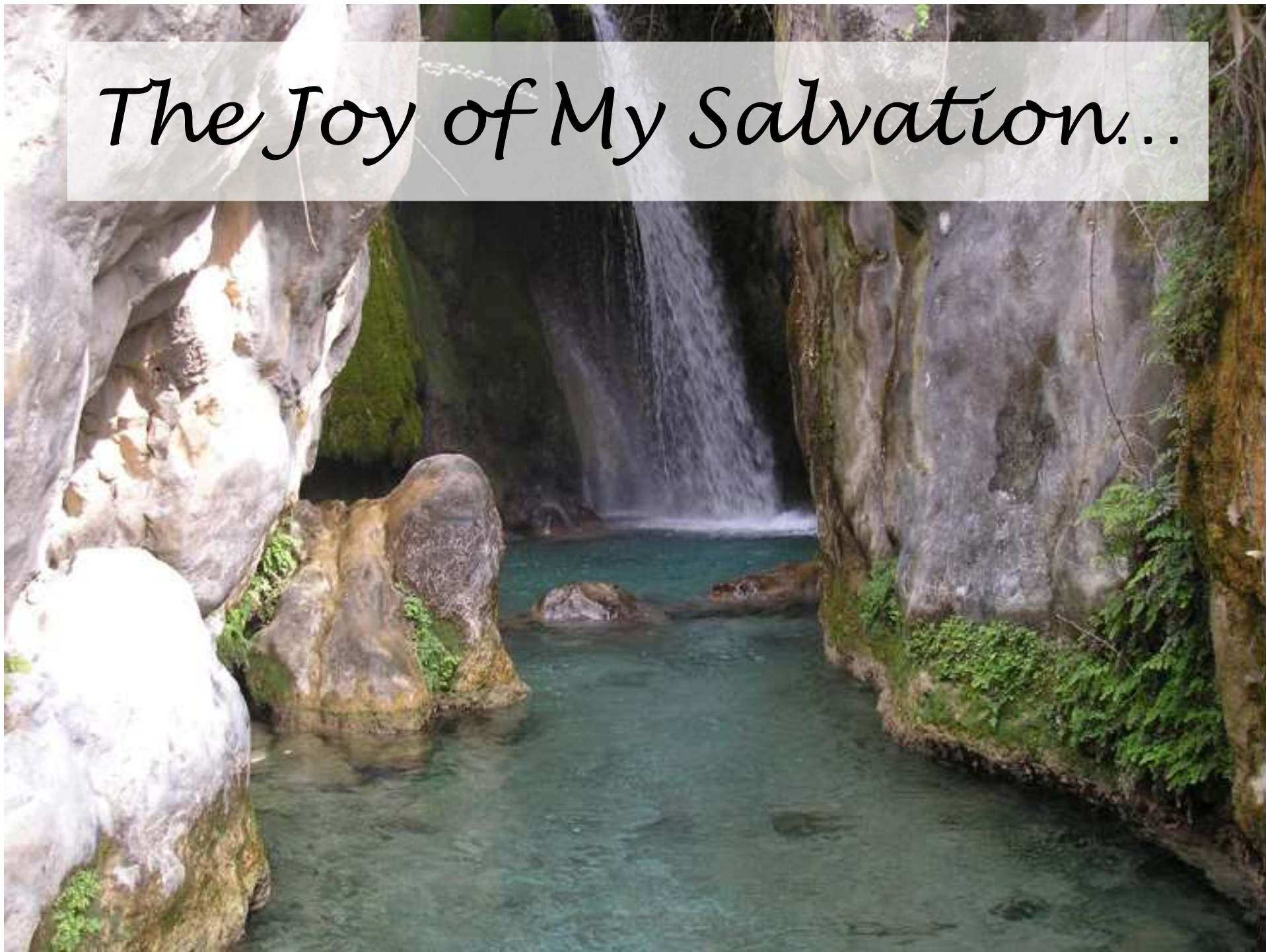
Vs. 11- They shall speak of the glory of thy kingdom, and talk of thy power;
