He came to the right person-not Pharisees/religious leaders

Matthew 23:2,3_(NKJV)

“The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat. "Therefore whatever they tell you to observe, that observe and do, but do not do according to their works; for they say, and do not do.”

He came to the right person-not Philosophers/ “In the know”
people of the day

Colossians 2:8_(NKJV)

“Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ.”

He came to the right person-not idol worshipers/other religions

Acts 17:16_(NKJV)

“Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was provoked within him when he saw that the city was given over to idols.”

He asked the right question-not for food/physical blessings

John 6:26,27^(NKJV)

“Jesus answered them and said, “Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled. “Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him.””

He asked the right question-not for a miracle/sign

Matthew 12:38,39_(NKJV)

“Then some of the scribes and Pharisees answered, saying, "Teacher, we want to see a sign from You." But He answered and said to them, "An evil and adulterous generation seeks after a sign, and no sign will be given to it except the sign of the prophet Jonah.”

He asked the right question-not an academic question

Acts 17:19-21_(NKJV)

“And they took him and brought him to the Areopagus, saying, “May we know what this new doctrine is of which you speak? “For you are bringing some strange things to our ears. Therefore we want to know what these things mean.” For all the Athenians and the foreigners who were there spent their time in nothing else but either to tell or to hear some new thing.”

He asked the right question-not to settle an argument

Luke 12:13,14_(NKJV)

“Then one from the crowd said to Him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." But He said to him, "Man, who made Me a judge or an arbitrator over you?"”

He got the right answer-not man's wisdom

Proverbs 16:25_(NKJV)

“There is a way that seems right to a man, But its end is the way of death.”

He got the right answer-not man's wisdom

John 8:28^(NKJV)

“Then Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things.”

He got the right answer-not a doctrine of demons/false doctrine

Mark 3:22-25_(NKJV)

“And the scribes who came down from Jerusalem said, "He has Beelzebub," and, "By the ruler of the demons He casts out demons." So He called them to Himself and said to them in parables: "How can Satan cast out Satan? "If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. "And if a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand.”

He got the right answer-not a tickling of the ears

Matthew 22:15-16^(NKJV)

“Then the Pharisees went and plotted how they might entangle Him in His talk. And they sent to Him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, "Teacher, we know that You are true, and teach the way of God in truth; nor do You care about anyone, for You do not regard the person of men.”

He got the right answer-the truth

John 14:6^(NKJV)

“Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.”

He had the wrong response

Matthew 19:17-20_(NKJV)

“So He said to him, "Why do you call Me good? No one is good but One, that is, God. But if you want to enter into life, keep the commandments." He said to Him, "Which ones?" Jesus said, "'You shall not murder,' 'You shall not commit adultery,' 'You shall not steal,' 'You shall not bear false witness,' 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'" The young man said to Him, "All these things I have kept from my youth. What do I still lack?"”

He had the wrong response

Luke 14:26,27_(NKJV)

“If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple. "And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple.”
