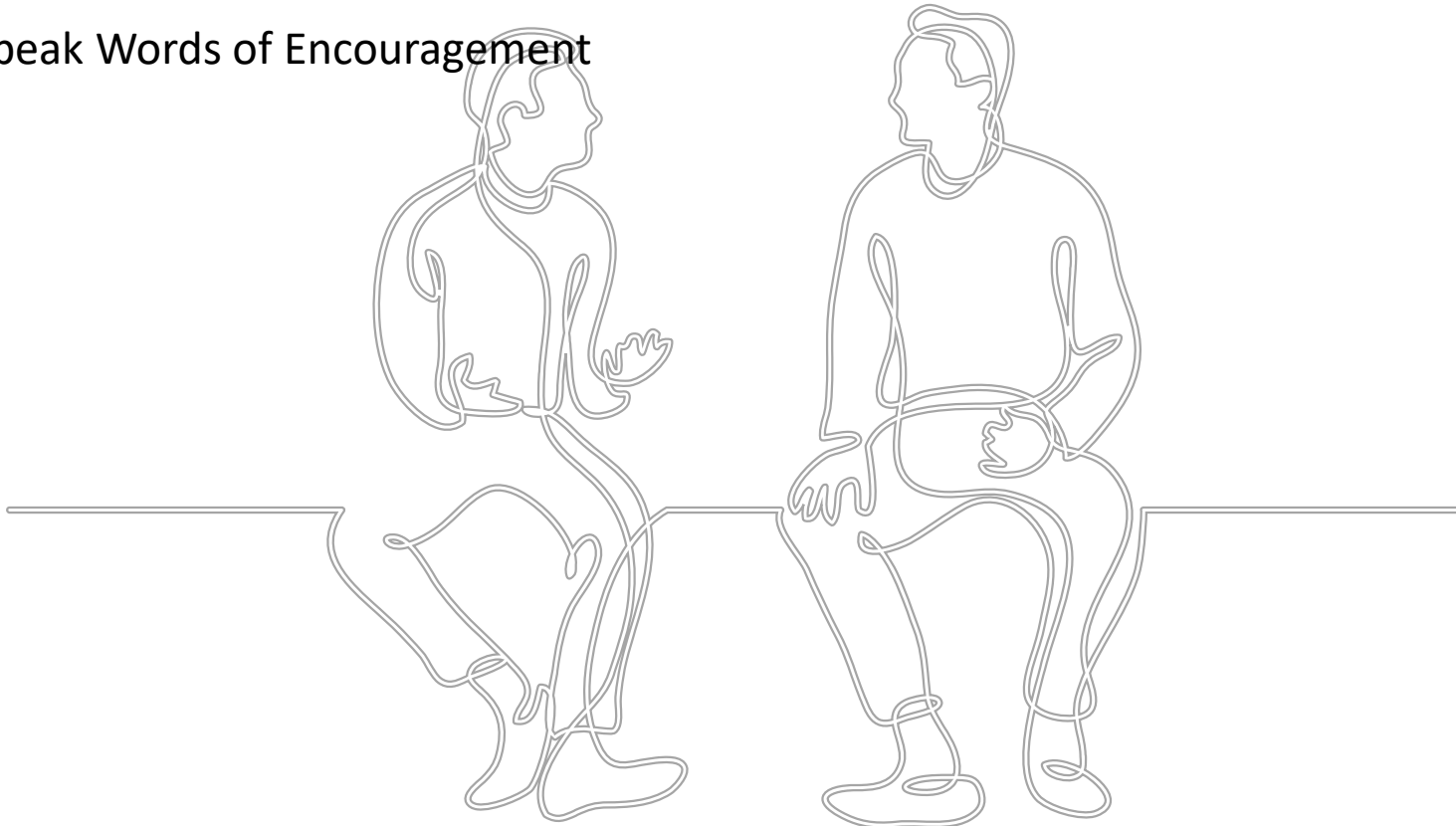

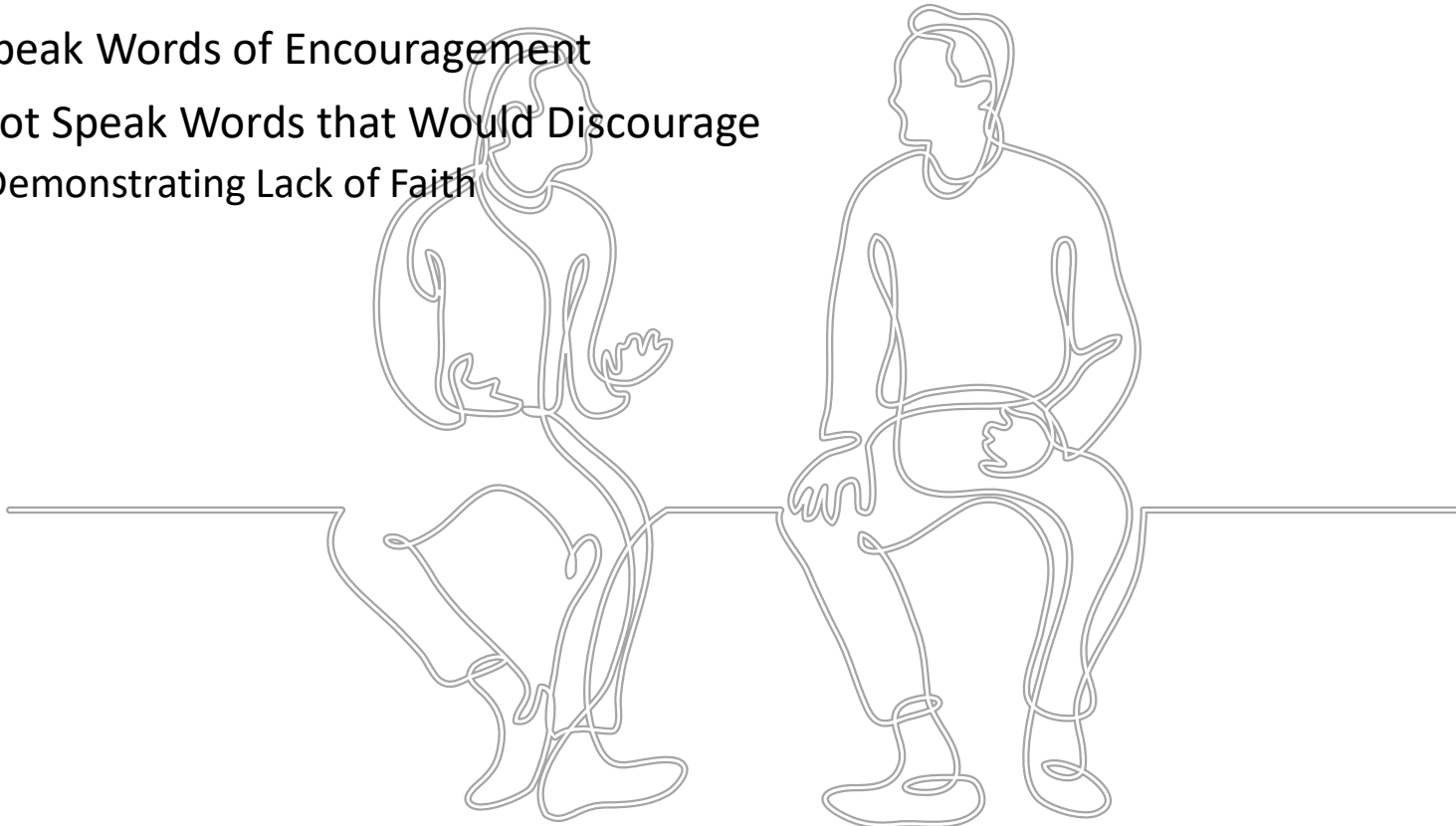
Do Speak Words of Encouragement

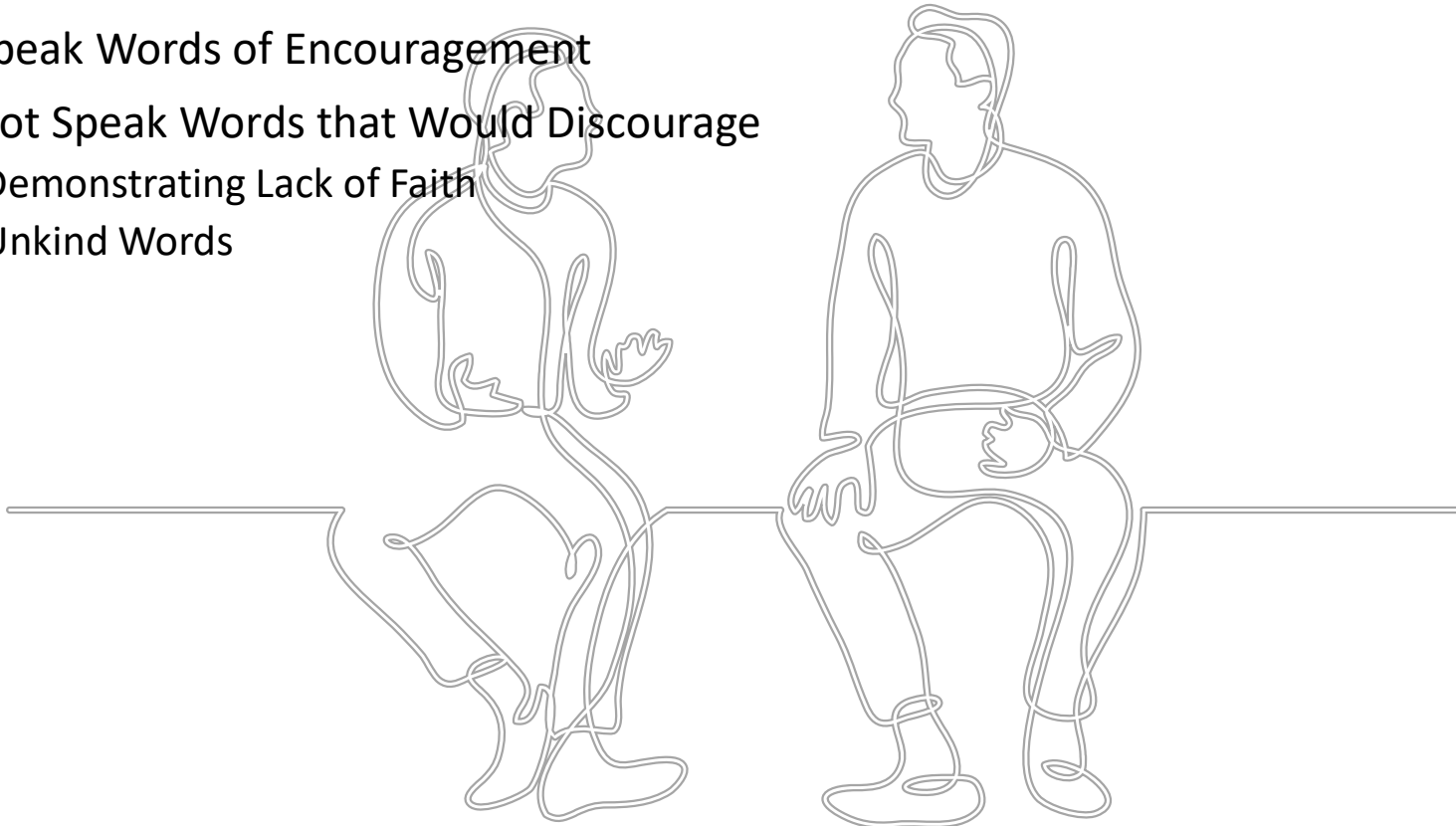
Do Not Speak Words that Would Discourage

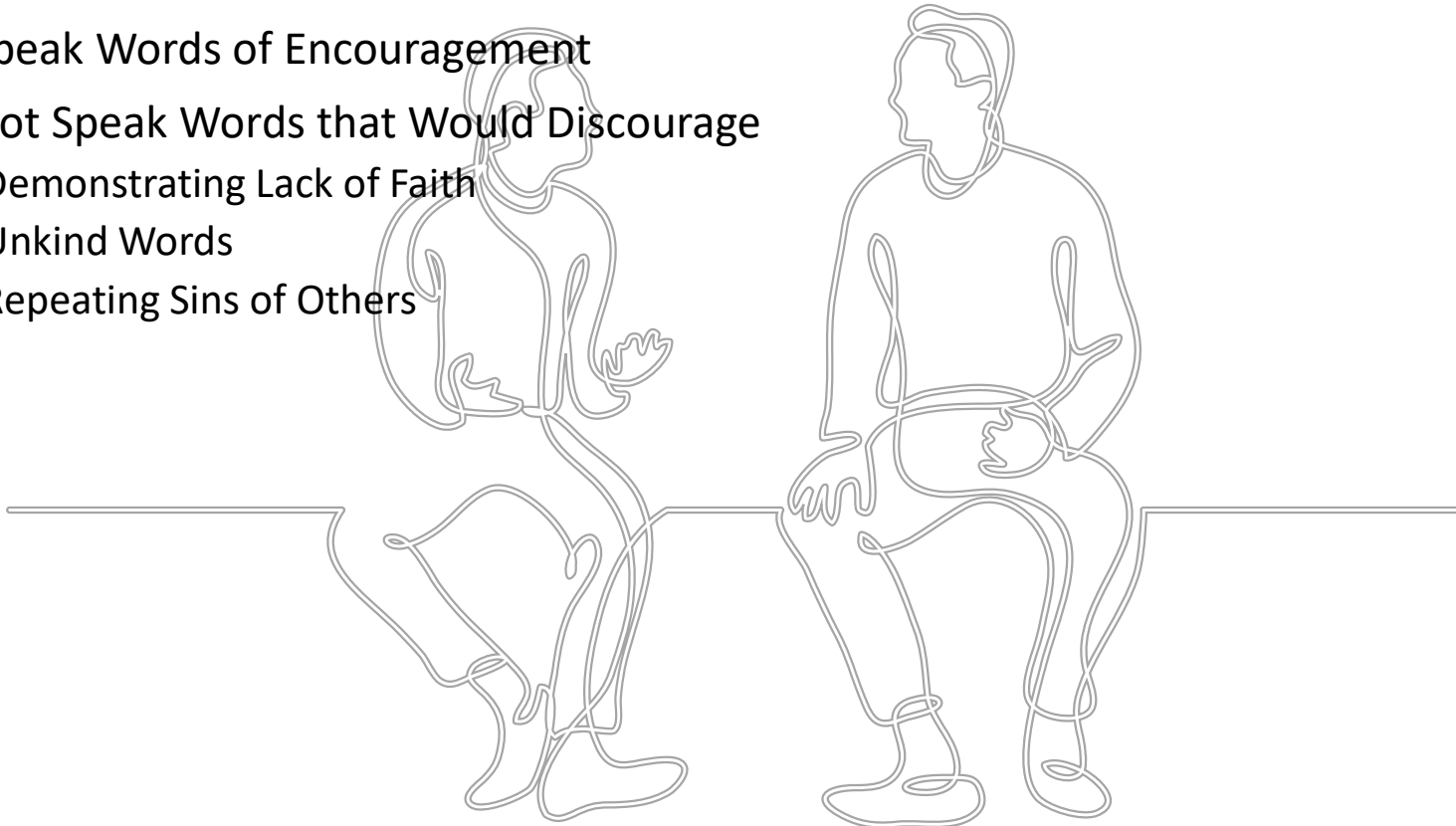

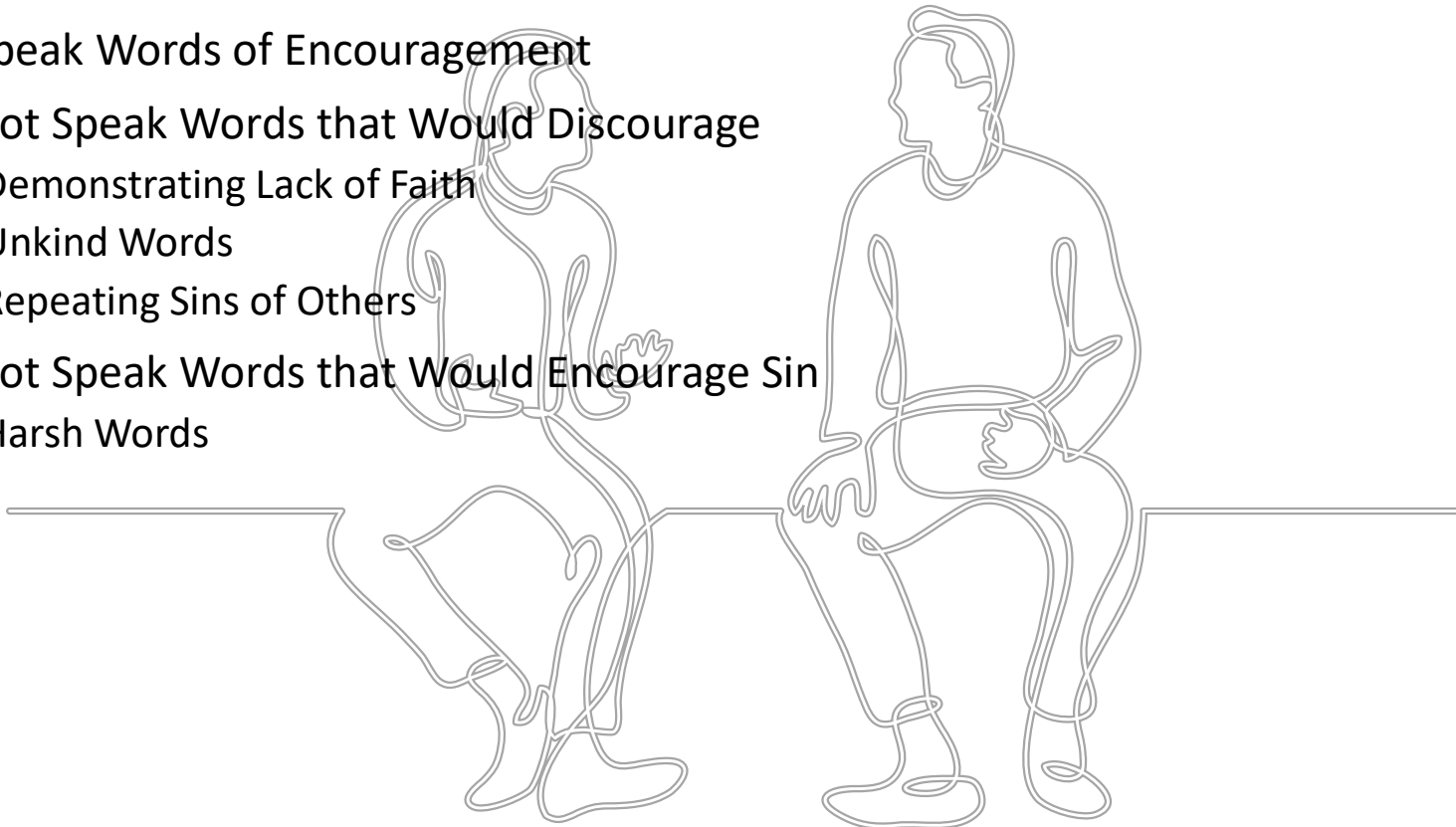
Do Not Speak Words that Would Discourage

“A soft answer turns away wrath, But a harsh word stirs up anger.”

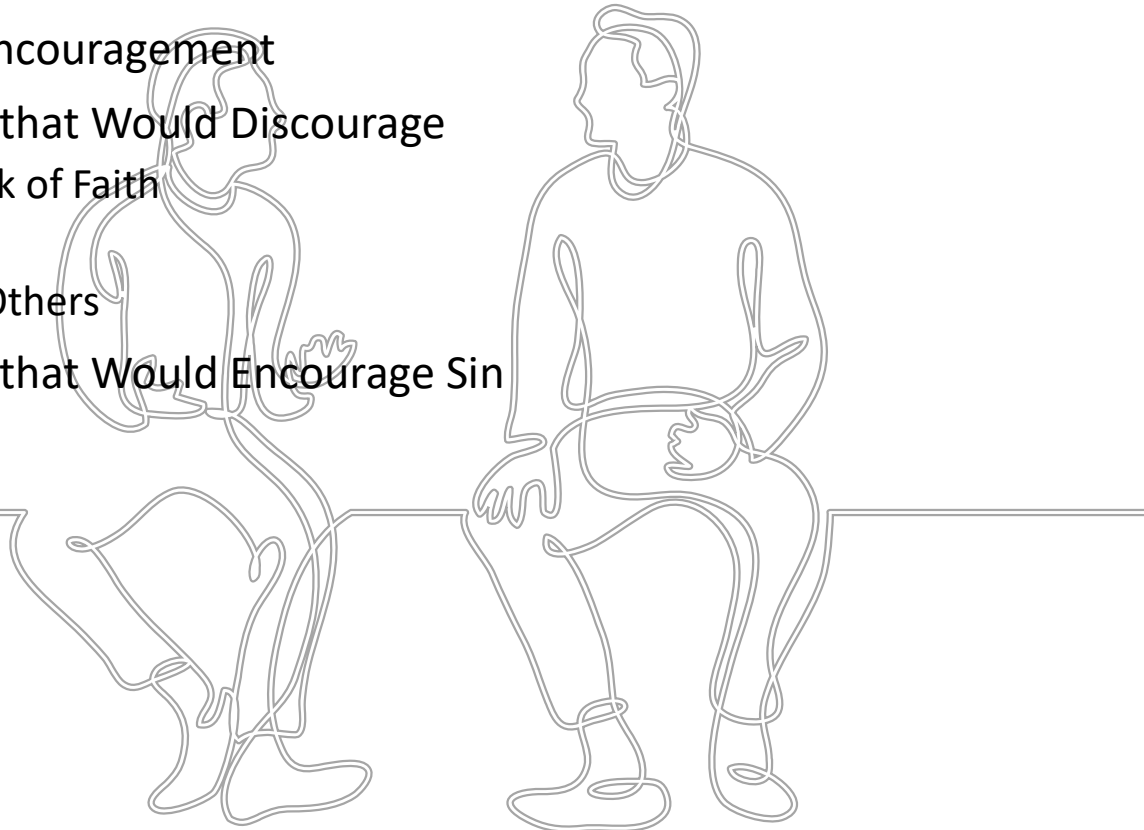

“Where there is no wood, the fire goes out; And where there is no talebearer, strife ceases.”

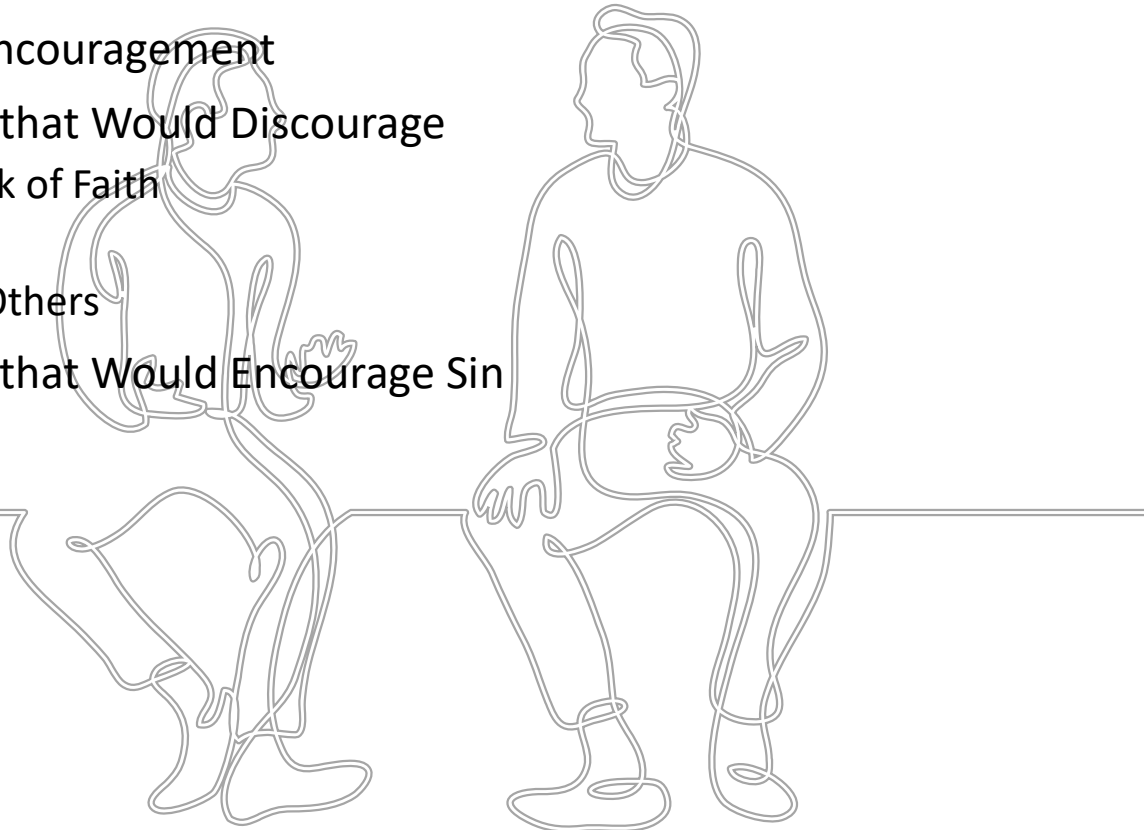
Do Not Speak Words that Would Encourage Sin

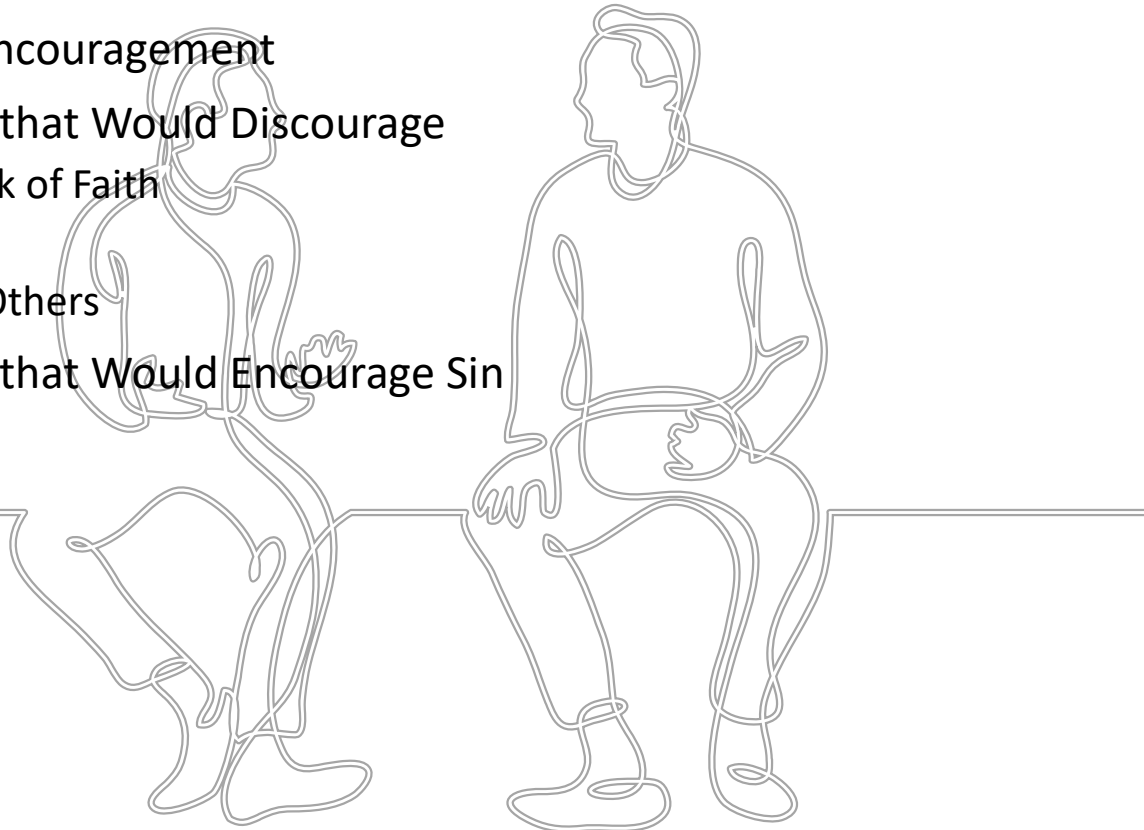

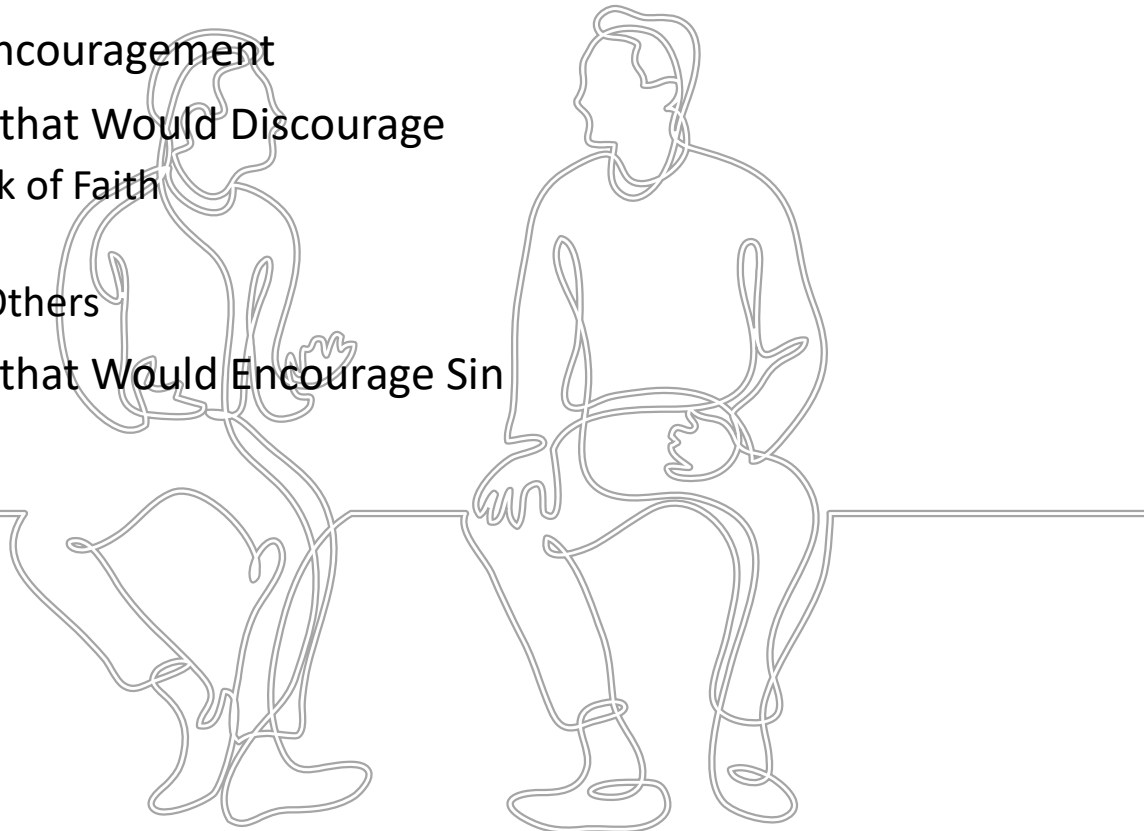
Know When to Talk

“Pleasant words are like a honeycomb, Sweetness to the soul and health to the bones.”

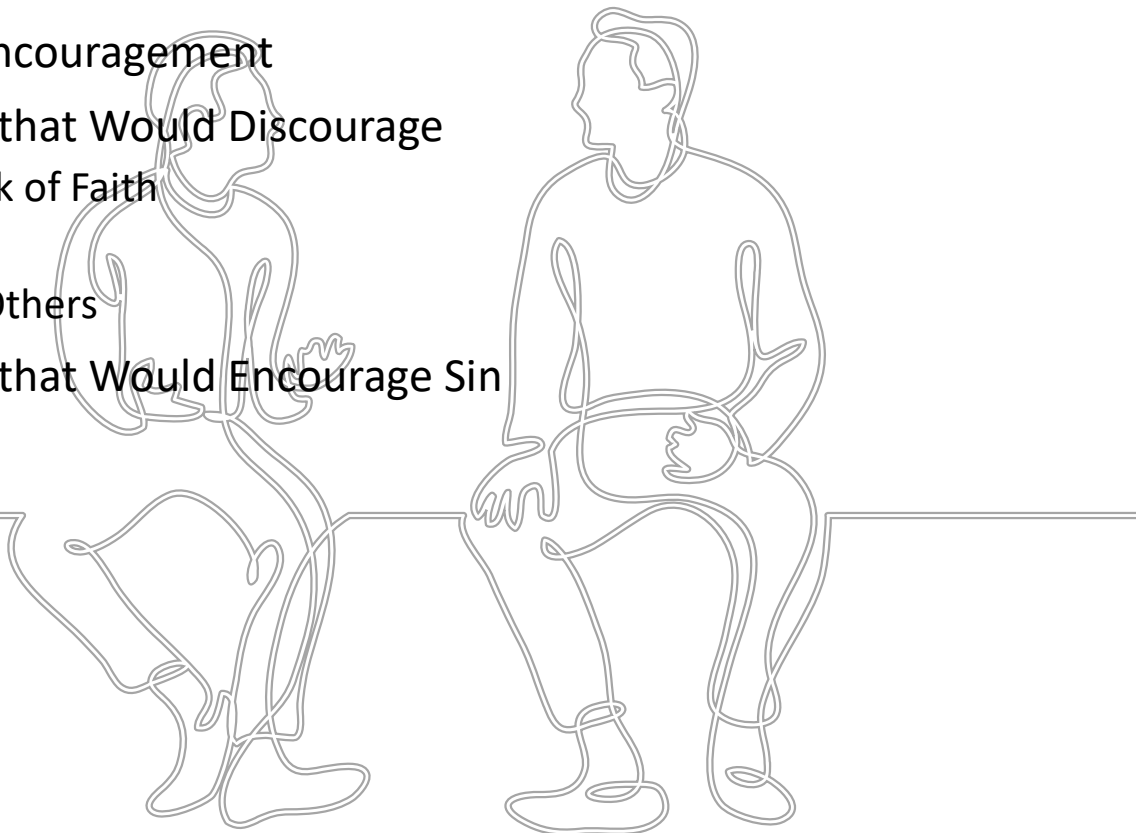
Use the Right Words

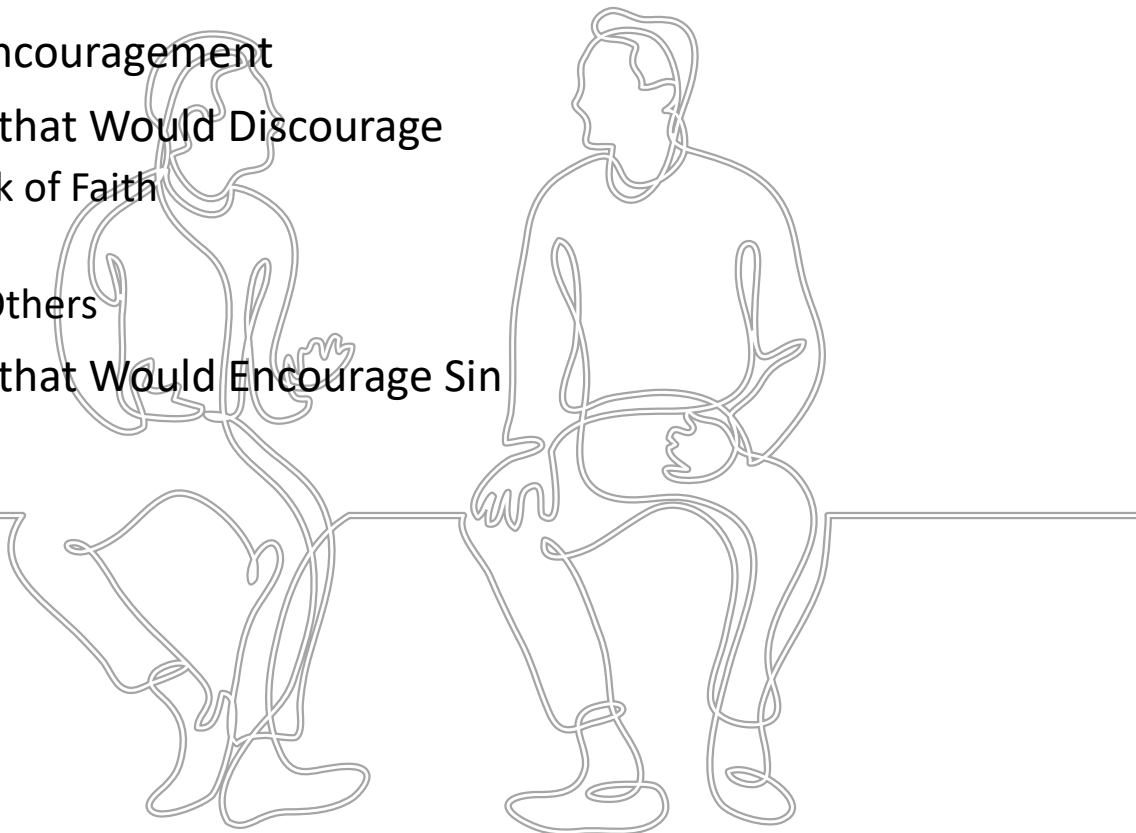
Speak with Wisdom
