- Wretched
- Miserable
- Poor
- Blind
- Naked



Luke warm - Complacency

PERGAMUM

- Held fast Jesus Name
- Did not deny my faith (even when Antipas was killed)
- Courageous in the face of death
- However, Neutral vs Action



Sin of Neutrality

EPHESUS

- Active workers in the Kingdom
- They tested those who claimed to be apostles
- Persevered and refused to tolerate false teaching
- Did not lose heart during their tribulations
- However, they left their first love



Left their first love

SMYRNA

- 1 of 2 that received only praise
- Withstanding tribulation even in the face of poverty
- Resisted the false accusations of the Jews
- Warned that even more tribulation was coming



Stand strong no matter the cost

- 50 miles east of Smyrna, so this was inland
- Known for rich deposits of gold (first place to use coins for trade) and intersection of 5 highways
- Unique fortification
