• Moses <u>encouraged</u> Joshua (Deuteronomy 1:38; 31:7-8).

• God foreknew what would happen (Deuteronomy 31:16-21).

"I know your rebellion and your stubbornness; behold, while I am still alive with you today, you have been rebellious against the LORD; how much more, then, after my death?" (Deuteronomy 31:27)

- Men love the darkness (John 3:19).
- Men exchange the truth of God (Romans 1:25, 29).
