- Modern day Turkish city of Akhisar "White Castle"
- Intersection of several valleys
- City of the Guilds
  - wool-workers, linen-workers, makers of outer garments, dyers, leather-workers, tanners, potters, bakers, slave-dealers, and bronzesmiths





## HISTORY OF THYATIRA

- Lydia "seller of purple"
- Paul's work in Asia Minor



Acts 16:14-15 "14 Now a certain woman named Lydia heard [us]. She was a seller of purple from the city of Thyatira, who worshiped God. The Lord opened her heart to heed the things spoken by Paul. 15 And when she and her household were baptized, she begged [us], saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come to my house and stay." So she persuaded us."

Revelation 2:18 "And to the angel of the church in Thyatira write, 'These things says the Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet like fine brass: "

- Son of God
- Eyes like flame of fire: piercing, illuminating, and/or consuming
- Feet like fine brass: firm, strong, and pure
  - Revelation 1:15, 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9

Revelation 2:19 "I know your works, love, service, faith, and your patience; and [as] for your works, the last [are] more than the first."

- The 5 Praises to Thyatira
- Stagnant vs Active Growth: Hebrews 5:12-14

"For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need [someone] to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food. 13 For everyone who partakes [only] of milk [is] unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. 14 But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, [that is], those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil."

Revelation 2:20-23 "Nevertheless I have a few things against you, because you allow that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, to teach and seduce My servants to commit sexual immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols. 21 And I gave her time to repent of her sexual immorality, and she did not repent. 22 "Indeed I will cast her into a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of their deeds." 23 "I will kill her children with death, and all the churches shall know that I am He who searches the minds and hearts. And I will give to each one of you according to your works."

- Obedience vs Disobedience
- 1st Century Challenges

- Comparison to Jezebel: 1 Kings 16:29-33
  - 1 Kings 18:4 Massacred the Lord's prophets
  - 1 Kings 18:19 Personally supported the pagan priests of Baal and Asherah
- Compare Ephesus to Pergamum to Thyatira
- No Toleration of sin: Ephesians 5:11, 1 Corinthians 5:6-7
- Jesus is merciful, but we can not forget that he is righteous: Romans 2:4-6
- Judgement will be severed: Ezekiel 16:36-41

Revelation 2:25-29 But hold fast what you have till I come. 26 And he who overcomes, and keeps My works until the end, to him I will give power over the nations—27 'He shall rule them with a rod of iron; They shall be dashed to pieces like the potter's vessels'--as I also have received from My Father; 28 "and I will give him the morning star. 29 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches

- Rule over nations: Psalms 2:8-9, Romans 8:37-39
- Rod of Iron: Isaiah 11:4, Ephesians 1:20-23, Hebrews 11:4, 7
- Morning Star: Revelation 22:16
