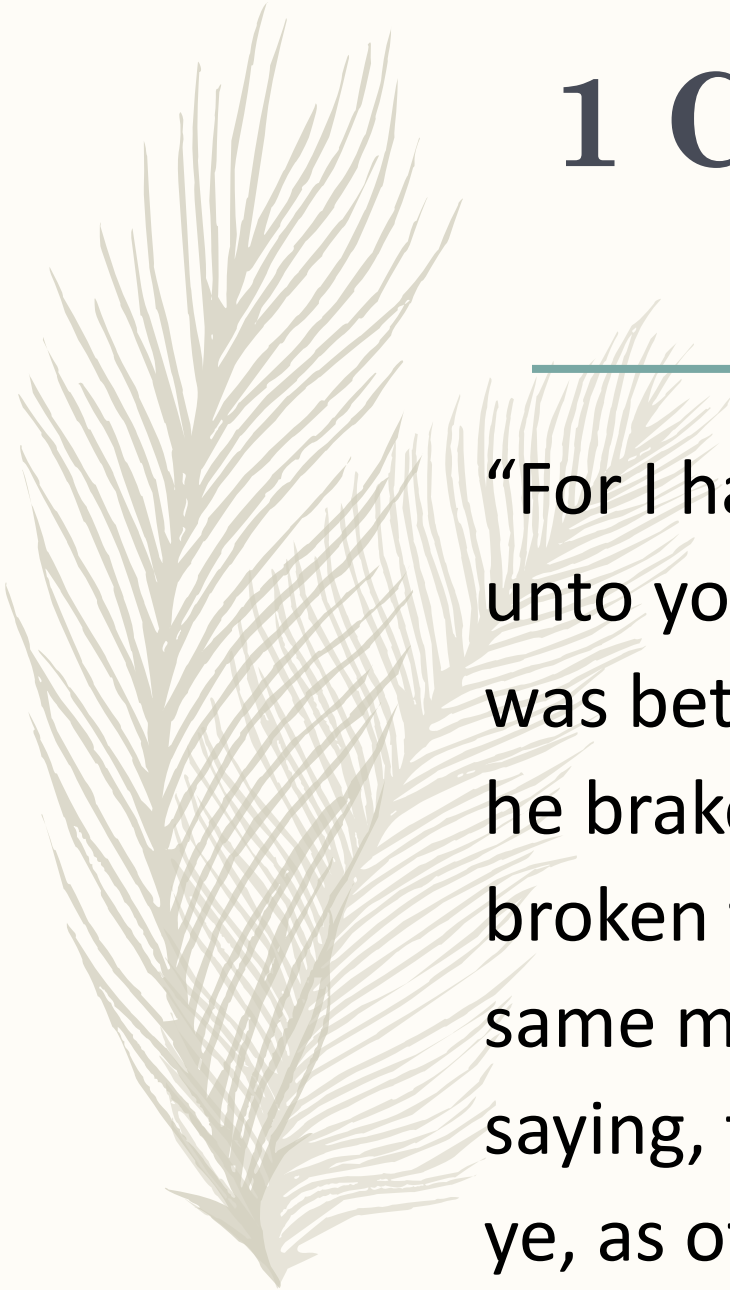

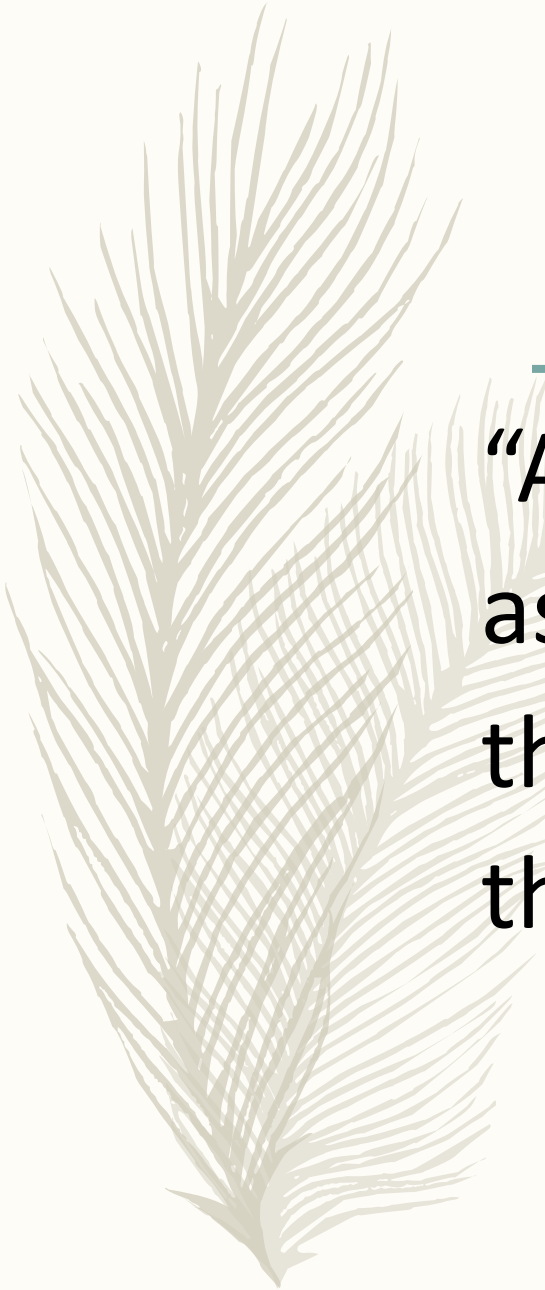

---

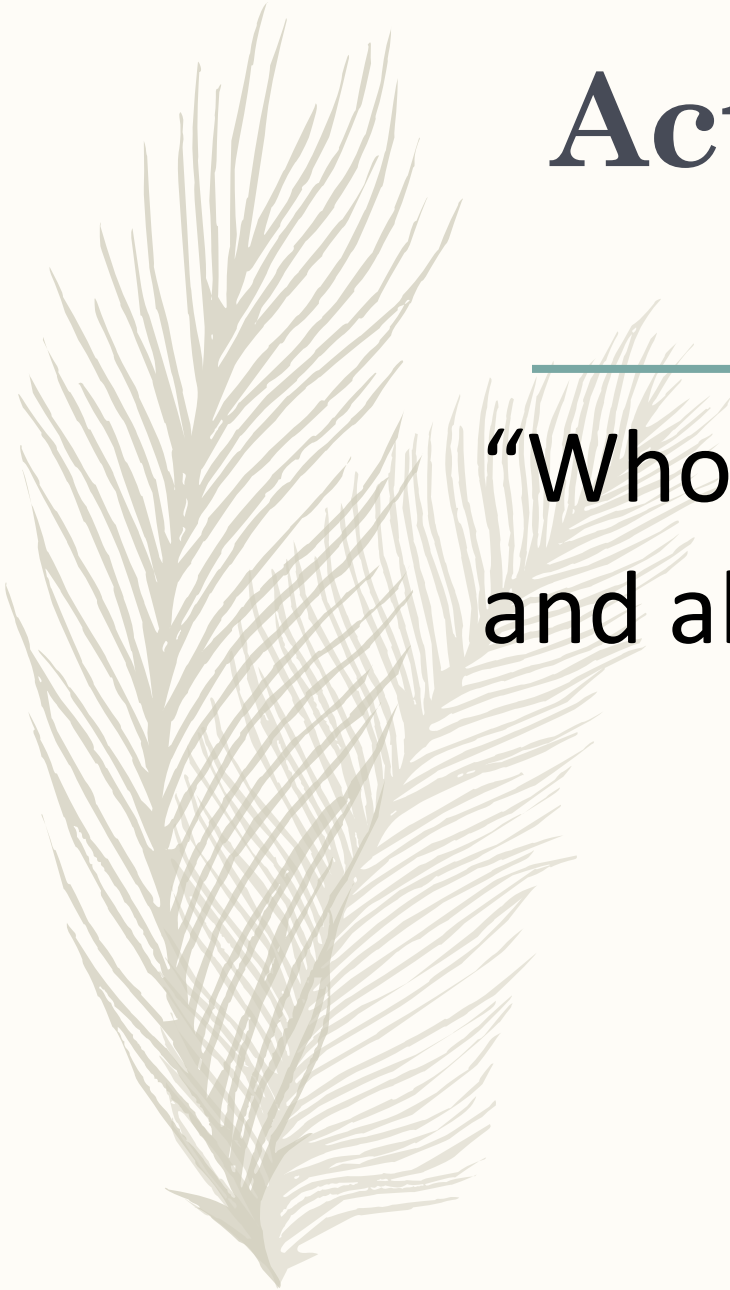

# 1 Peter 1:18-19

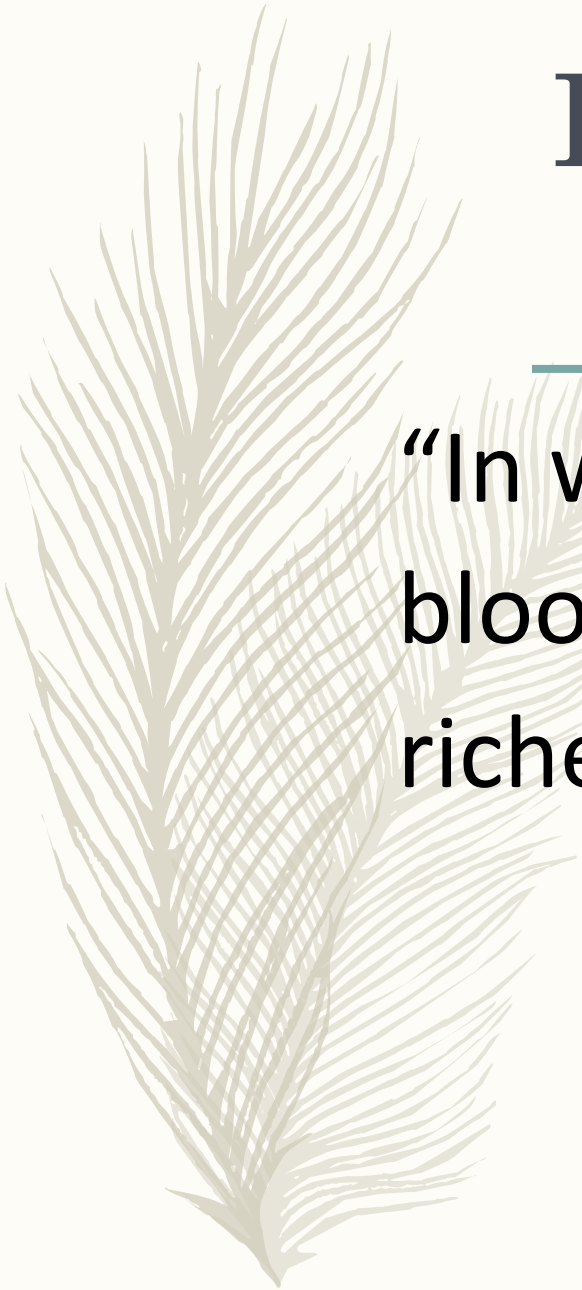
---

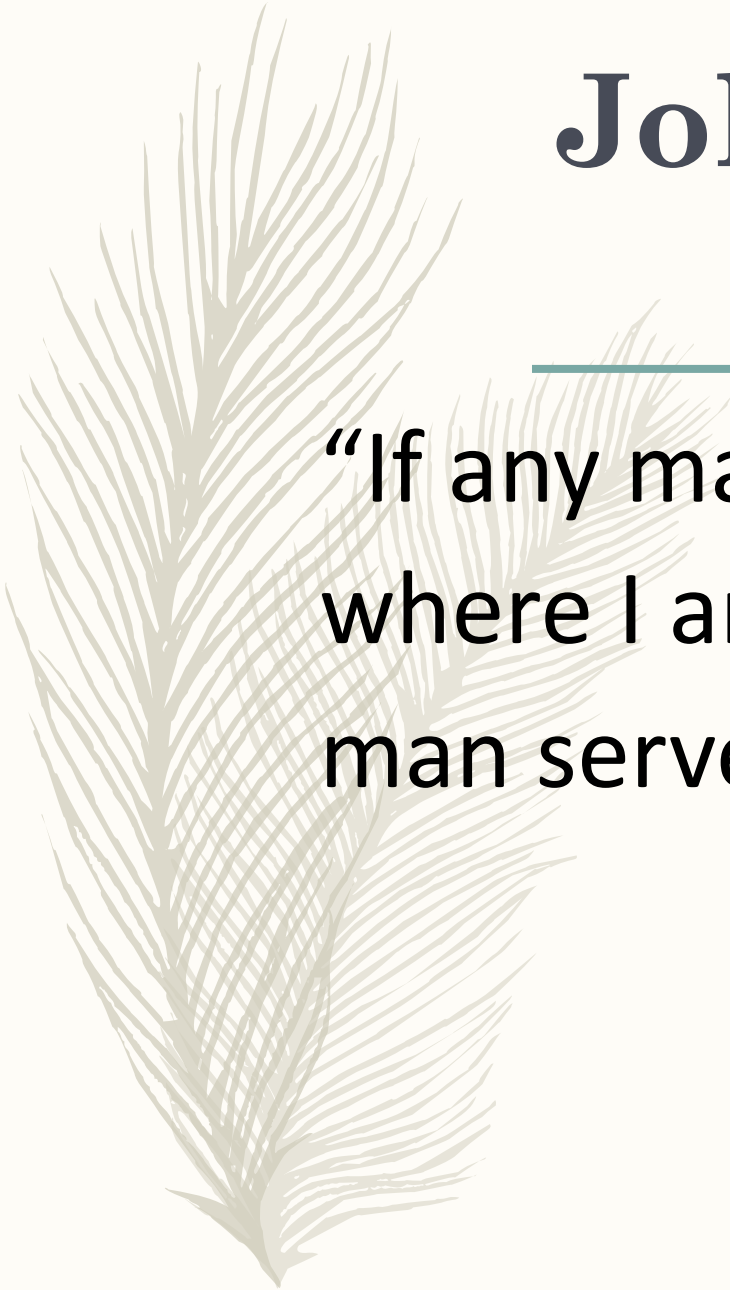
