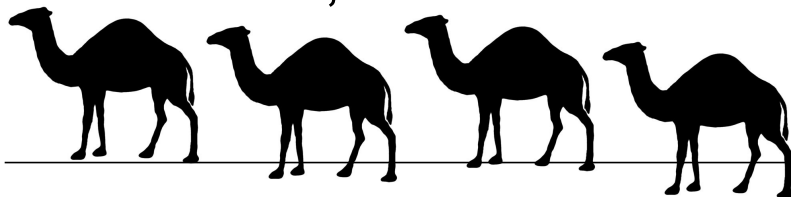
I John 4:1

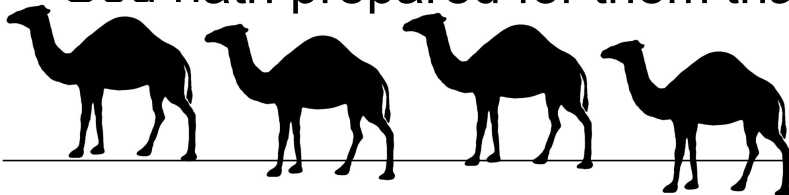
II Peter 1:16

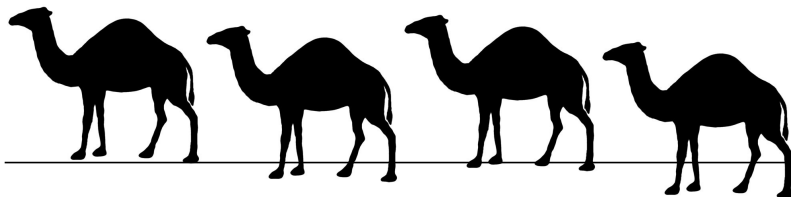

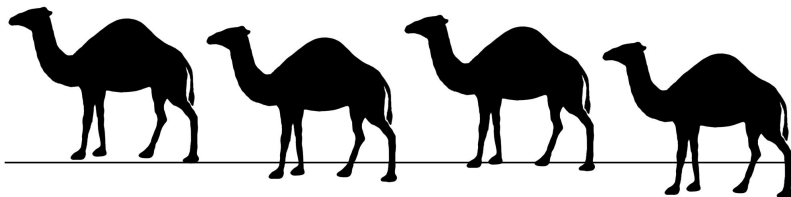

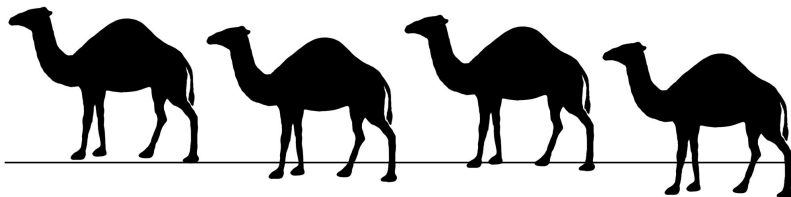
Hebrews 13:12,15
