US MORAL FREEFALL - SURVEY FINDS...

"Our nation is facing a potential moral freefall unthinkable to earlier generations—with a majority of Americans today no longer embracing values of honesty, respect for the rule of law, the sanctity of life, and traditional sexual morality when facing moral issues."

US MORAL FREEFALL - SURVEY FINDS...

Survey Results:

- When making moral choices
 - Less than 1/3 of American Adults rely on religious faith (29%)
 - Instead (30%) rely on other people
 - Or their own personal beliefs, feelings, or experiences (31%)
- Less than half (48%) who proclaimed to have a "belief" in God were likely to rely on the Bible for primary moral guidance
 - Between the ages of 18 to 19, only (15%) were likely to turn to the Bible for moral guidance
 - Instead they tend to look to themselves (29%) or to family (25%)



- Thayer's Lexicon defines this to mean to shun or avoid by flight something abhorrent, especially vices



- Thayer's Lexicon defines this to set oneself against, to withstand, resist, oppose




