- 1.46 million births (40.5 percent of all births) in 2020 occurred out of wedlock.
- 43 percent of first marriages dissolve within fifteen years; about 60 percent of divorcing couples have children; and approximately one million children each year experience the divorce of their parents.

- Over 3.3 million children live with an unmarried parent and the parent's cohabiting partner.
- The number of cohabiting couples with children has nearly doubled since 1990, from 891,000 to 1.7 million today.

 26 percent of absent fathers live in a different state than their children; and 50 percent of children living absent their father have never set foot in their father's home.


