



Focus on personality and teachings of Jesus




THALLUS (a Samaritan historian, ca. 52 A.D.)

• Wrote attempting to give a natural explanation for the darkness which occurred at the crucifixion of Jesus.




LETTER OF Mara bar Sarapion, a Syriac Stoic philosopher (written to his son, ca. 73 A.D.)

 "What advantage did the Jews gain from executing their wise king?...Nor did the wise king die for good; he lived on in the teaching which he had given."



Roman Historian CORNELIUS TACITUS (ca. 112 A.D.)

• "...Their originator, Christ, had been executed in Tiberius' reign by the governor of Judea Pontius Pilatus."



Pliny The Younger in about AD 112, Governor of Bithynia in Asia Minor

Wrote to the emperor Trajan about
 Christians and their devotion to Christ



SEUTONIUS (Court official and annalist under Hadrian, 120 A.D.)

- "As the Jews were making constant disturbance at the instigation of Chrestus, he expelled them from Rome."
- Acts 18:1-2 "After these things Paul departed from Athens and went to Corinth. 2 And he found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, who had recently come from Italy with his wife Priscilla (because Claudius had commanded all the Jews to depart from Rome); and he came to them."




#### The Talmud

- Consists of two separate books dealing with Jewish law, written during the period from 100 A.D. to 500 A.D.
- Speaks frequently of Jesus of Nazareth



FLAVIUS JOSEPHUS (A Jewish general turned Roman historian, born 37 A.D.)

- Makes a couple references to Jesus in his History Of The Jews
- E.g., "...and brought before it the brother of Jesus, the so-called Christ, whose name was James."



H. G. WELLS (an atheist, wrote Outline of History)

• "...one is obliged to say, 'Here was a man. This part of the tale could not have been invented.'"



WILL DURANT ()Ex-professor of Philosophy of History at Columbia University)

 He spent two chapters in The Story Of Our Civilization depicting Jesus as a historical figure right along with the Caesars




#### LEE STROBLE


- Did Jesus Exist?

## WHO IS JESUS?

Charles Templeton wrote Farewell to God - My reasons for rejecting the Christian Faith

• "He was the greatest human being who has ever lived. He was a moral genius. His ethical sense was unique. He was the intrinsically wisest person that I've ever encountered in my life or in my reading. His commitment was total and led to his own death, much to the detriment of the world."



#### Observations: Fulfilling Prophecies

- Chronicled Jesus' life for over a thousand years before he was born
- Luke 24:25-27, 44 NKJV] 25 Then He said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! 26 "Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory? 27 And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.

#### Observations: Fulfilling Prophecies

- The Messiah was to be born in Bethlehem in Judea (Micah 5:2)
- The Messiah was to be born of a virgin (Isaiah 7:14)
- He was to be a regal monarch of a kingdom that would never end (Psalm 89:3-4; Isaiah 9:6-7; Psalm 110:1) and at the same time a suffering servant (Isaiah 53)
- He was to be betrayed by a friend (Psalm 41:9) for 30 pieces of silver (Zechariah 11:13)
- The Lord's Ruler would come into Jerusalem riding on the foal of a donkey (Zechariah 9:9)
- Even though His physical suffering would be severe, His bones would not be broken (Psalm 34:20)
- We can outline the Lord's entire crucifixion by only reading the OT
- And so many more...

- Isaiah 35:5-6 "Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, And the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. 6 Then the lame shall leap like a deer, And the tongue of the dumb sing. For waters shall burst forth in the wilderness, And streams in the desert."
- Nature
  - Turning the water to grape juice in John 2:1-11
  - Calming the Sea of Galilee during a turbulent storm in Matthew 8:23-27

- Death
  - Widow of Main's son in Luke 7:14-15
  - Lazerus after being dead for four days in John 11:1-44
  - As an evidence to John who baptized that he was Christ in Matthew 11:5
- Demons
  - Luke 11:14, Matthew 8:16, Mark 1:34 and more

- Jesus rose from the dead
  - Romans 1:4 [and] declared [to be] the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.
  - Acts 1:22 "beginning from the baptism of John to that day when He was taken up from us, one of these must become a witness with us of His resurrection."

- And many that weren't recorded
  - John 20:30-31 NKJV] 30 And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; 31 but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

#### Observations: Jesus Never Sinned

- A question that has stood the test of time
  - John 8:46 we read "Which of you convicts Me of sin? And if I tell the truth, why do you not believe Me?"
- Versus man's state: Romans 3:23 "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,"

#### Observations: Jesus Never Sinned

- 1Peter 1:19 "but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot."
- Hebrews 4:15 "For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all [points] tempted as [we are, yet] without sin."

#### Observations: Jesus Accepted Worship

 Exodus 20:3-5"You shall have no other gods before Me. 4 "You shall not make for yourself a carved image--any likeness [of anything] that [is] in heaven above, or that [is] in the earth beneath, or that [is] in the water under the earth; 5 you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the LORD your God, [am] a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth [generations] of those who hate Me,

#### Observations: Jesus Accepted Worship

- Revelation 19:10 "And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "See [that you do] not [do that]! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."
- However, Jesus did not stop those who worshipped him
  - Matthew 14:33 Then those who were in the boat came and worshiped Him, saying, "Truly You are the Son of God."
  - John 9:38 Then he said, "Lord, I believe!" And he worshiped Him

Observations: Discipleship attracts regardless of the cost

- Revelation 2:13 "I know your works, and where you dwell, where
  Satan's throne is. And you hold fast to My name, and did not deny My
  faith even in the days in which Antipas was My faithful martyr, who was
  killed among you, where Satan dwells."
- Revelation 2:9 ""I know your works, tribulation, and poverty (but you are rich); and *I know* the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not, but *are* a synagogue of Satan."

### WHO IS JESUS

- Did Jesus Exist? YES
- Is Jesus the son of God/Deity? YES
  - Fulfilling Prophecies
  - Performed Miracles
  - Jesus Never Sinned

  - Discipleship attracts regardless of the cost

JOHN 10:25, 30, 37-38"JESUS ANSWERED THEM, "I TOLD YOU, AND YOU DO NOT BELIEVE. THE WORKS THAT I DO IN MY FATHER'S NAME, THEY BEAR WITNESS OF ME. ... 30 "I AND [MY] FATHER ARE ONE." ... 37 "IF I DO NOT DO THE WORKS OF MY FATHER, DO NOT BELIEVE ME; 38 "BUT IF I DO, THOUGH YOU DO NOT BELIEVE ME, BELIEVE THE WORKS, THAT YOU MAY KNOW AND BELIEVE THAT THE FATHER [IS] IN ME, AND I IN HIM."
