“You have become estranged from Christ, you who attempt to be justified by law; you have fallen from grace.”

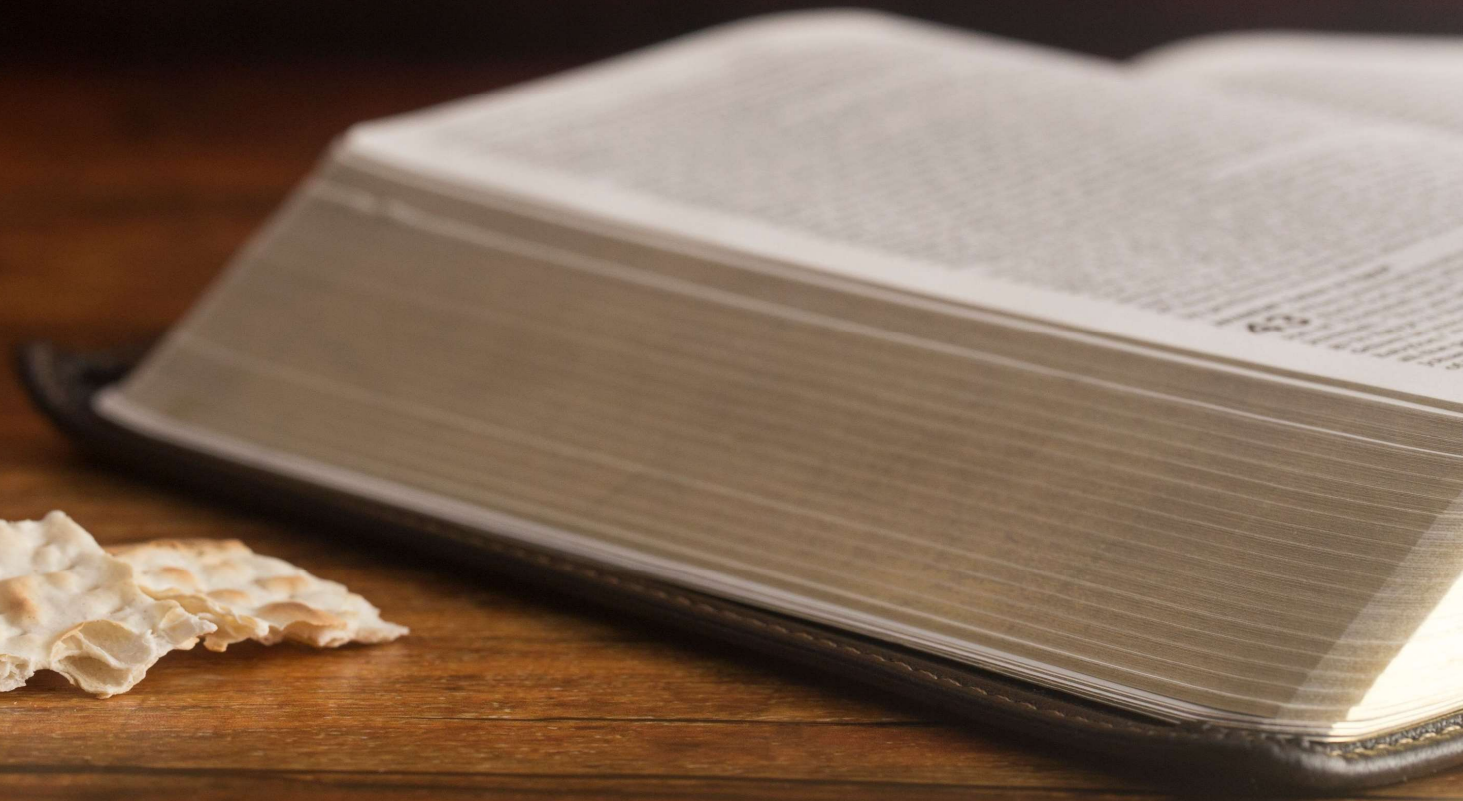
## Matthew 26:26-29 (NKJV)

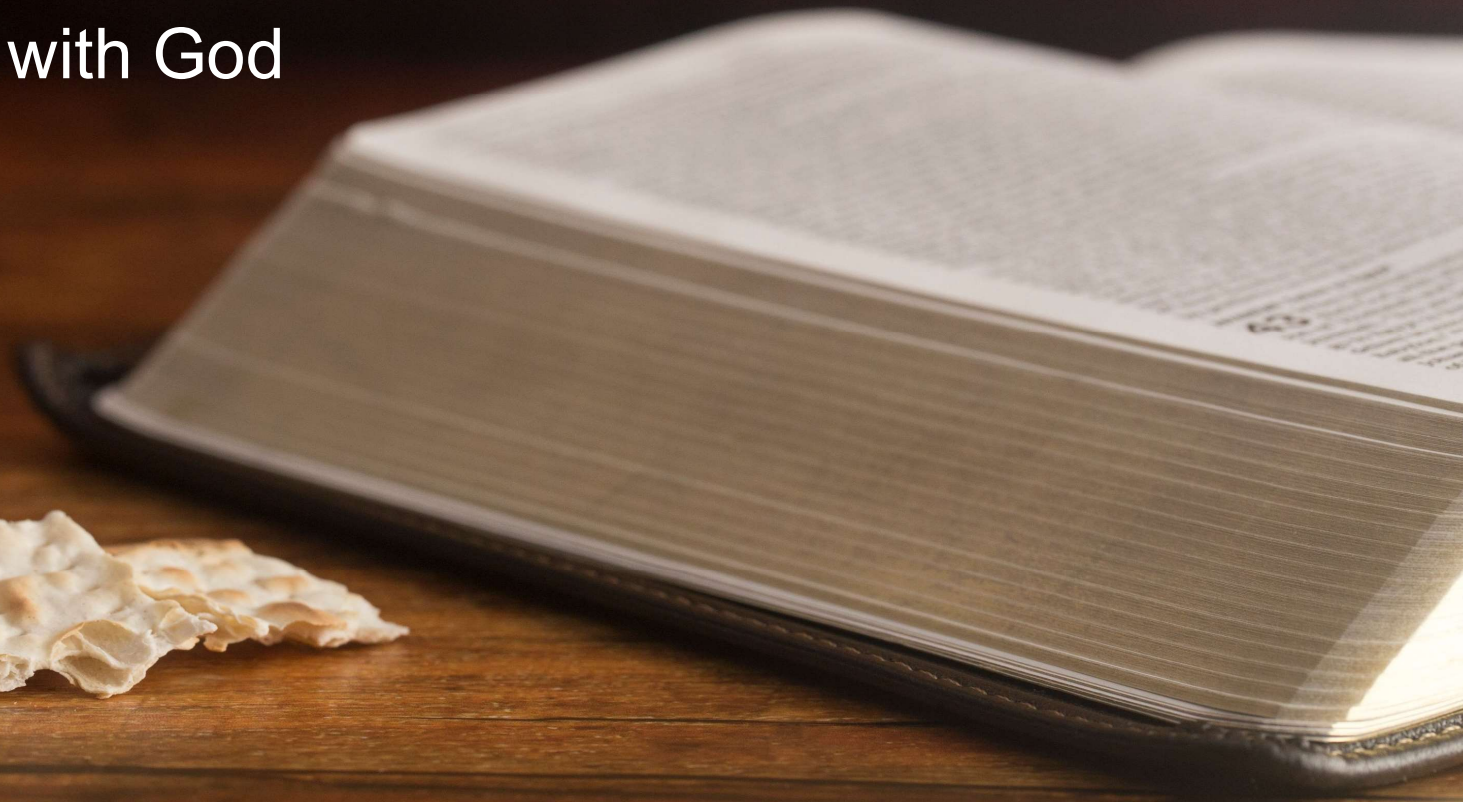
Hebrews 10:4<sub>(NKJV)</sub>

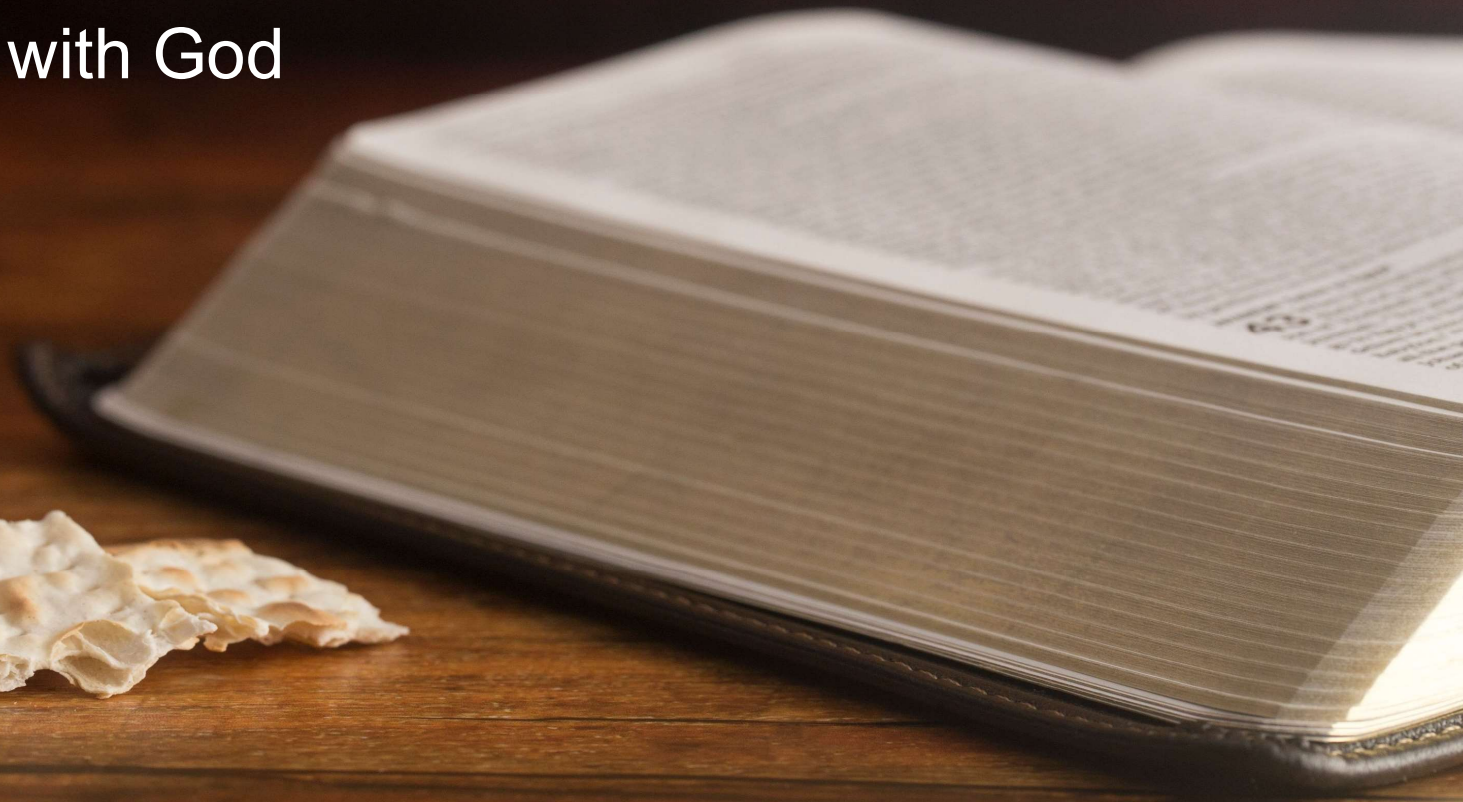
## I Corinthians 11:28<sub>(NKJV)</sub>
