

- Out of darkness into light (1 Pet. 2:9)





Denominational

Idea: God's people are divided into various sects To be in a denomination – subscribe to creed, et. al.

Non- Denominational


Church is not a part of any denomination The church is singular

Inter - Denominational

Idea: we accept any and all. All believe different things – but worship together
