- Versus the Bible, and only the Bible?
 - Deuteronomy 12:32 "Everything that I command you, you shall be careful to do. You shall not add to it or take from it."
 - Mark 7:7-9 "And in vain they worship Me, Teaching [as] doctrines the commandments of men.' 8 "For laying aside the commandment of God, you hold the tradition of men--the washing of pitchers and cups, and many other such things you do." 9 He said to them, "[All too] well you reject the commandment of God, that you may keep your tradition.
 - 2 Timothy 3:16-17 "All Scripture [is] given by inspiration of God, and [is] profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work."

- Christ is head
 - Colossians 1:18 "And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence."
 - Ephesians 1:22-23 "And He put all [things] under His feet, and gave Him [to be] head over all [things] to the church, 23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all."

- The body is composed of individuals
 - 1 Corinthians 12:12-14, 27 "For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also [is] Christ. 13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body--whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free--and have all been made to drink into one Spirit. 14 For in fact the body is not one member but many. ... 27 Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. "

 - Colossians 3:16 "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord."

 - Acts 2:42 "And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers."



Smyrna	Lived faithfully through persecution	- Stood strong in face of tribulation - Resisted false accusations and blasphemy	- Nothing	- More persecution was coming, Hold Fast
Philadelphia	Kept the command to persevere	- Small in number but served the Lord - Spiritual warfare against the synagogue of Satan, the Jews	- Nothing	- Hold fast
Ephesus	Left their 1st Love	 Active workers in the Kingdom Tested those who claimed to be apostles Refused to tolerate false teaching Kept heart during tribulations 	- Left their zeal/ passion for Christ	- Give God our hearts and obedience
Pergamum	The neutral church	Held fast Jesus NameDid not deny my faithCourageous in the face of death	- Stood neutral to address those following Nicolaitans and Balaam	- Address and respond to sin, no matter where it occurs
Thyatira	The compromised church	- Acknowledged their works, love, service, faith, patience, and continued growth	- Allowed false prophetess to compromise the group	- Judgement is coming - Faithful to remain clean
