

Romans 11:33 "Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable [are] His judgments and His ways past finding out!"

Psalm 139:6 "Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; It is high, I cannot attain it."

Isaiah 55:8-9 "For My thoughts [are] not your thoughts, Nor [are] your ways My ways," says the LORD. 9 "For [as] the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts."

But we have the mind of Christ."

God is Love: 1 John 4:8 "He who does not love does not know God, for God is love."


God is Logical: 1 Corinthians 14:33 "For God is not [the author] of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints."

God is Just: Acts 10:34-35 "Then Peter opened [his] mouth and said: "In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality. 35 "But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him."

NKJV: Genesis 22:1 "Now it came to pass after these things that God tested Abraham, and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am."

ASV: Genesis 22:1 "And it came to pass after these things, that God did prove Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham; and he said, Here am I."

ESV: Genesis 22:1 "After these things God tested Abraham and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am."

1 Samuel 17:39 "and David strapped his sword over his armor. And he tried in vain to go, for he had not tested them. Then David said to Saul, "I cannot go with these, for I have not **tested** them." So David put them off."

Genesis 22:1 "Now it came to pass after these things that God tested Abraham, and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am."

Hebrews 11:17 "By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten [son],"

Deuteronomy 8:16 "who fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers did not know, that He might humble you and that He might test you, to do you good in the end—"

Genesis 3:1-6 "Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?" 2 And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; 3 "but of the fruit of the tree which [is] in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.' " 4 Then the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. 5 "For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." 6 So when the woman saw that the tree [was] good for food, that it [was] pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make [one] wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate."

Jeremiah 35:12-16 "Then came the word of the LORD to Jeremiah, saying, 13 "Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: 'Go and tell the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, "Will you not receive instruction to obey My words?" says the LORD. 14 "The words of Jonadab the son of Rechab, which he commanded his sons, not to drink wine, are performed; for to this day they drink none, and obey their father's commandment. But although I have spoken to you, rising early and speaking, you did not obey Me. 15 "I have also sent to you all My servants the prophets, rising up early and sending [them], saying, 'Turn now everyone from his evil way, amend your doings, and do not go after other gods to serve them; then you will dwell in the land which I have given you and your fathers.' But you have not inclined your ear, nor obeyed Me. 16 "Surely the sons of Jonadab the son of Rechab have performed the commandment of their father, which he commanded them, but this people has not obeyed Me."

1 Corinthians 10:13 "No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God [is] faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear [it]."

JAMES 1:2 - 4 "MY BRETHREN, COUNT IT ALL JOY WHEN YOU FALL INTO VARIOUS TRIALS, 3 KNOWING THAT THE TESTING OF YOUR FAITH PRODUCES PATIENCE. 4 BUT LET PATIENCE HAVE [ITS] PERFECT WORK, THAT YOU MAY BE PERFECT AND COMPLETE, LACKING NOTHING."
