

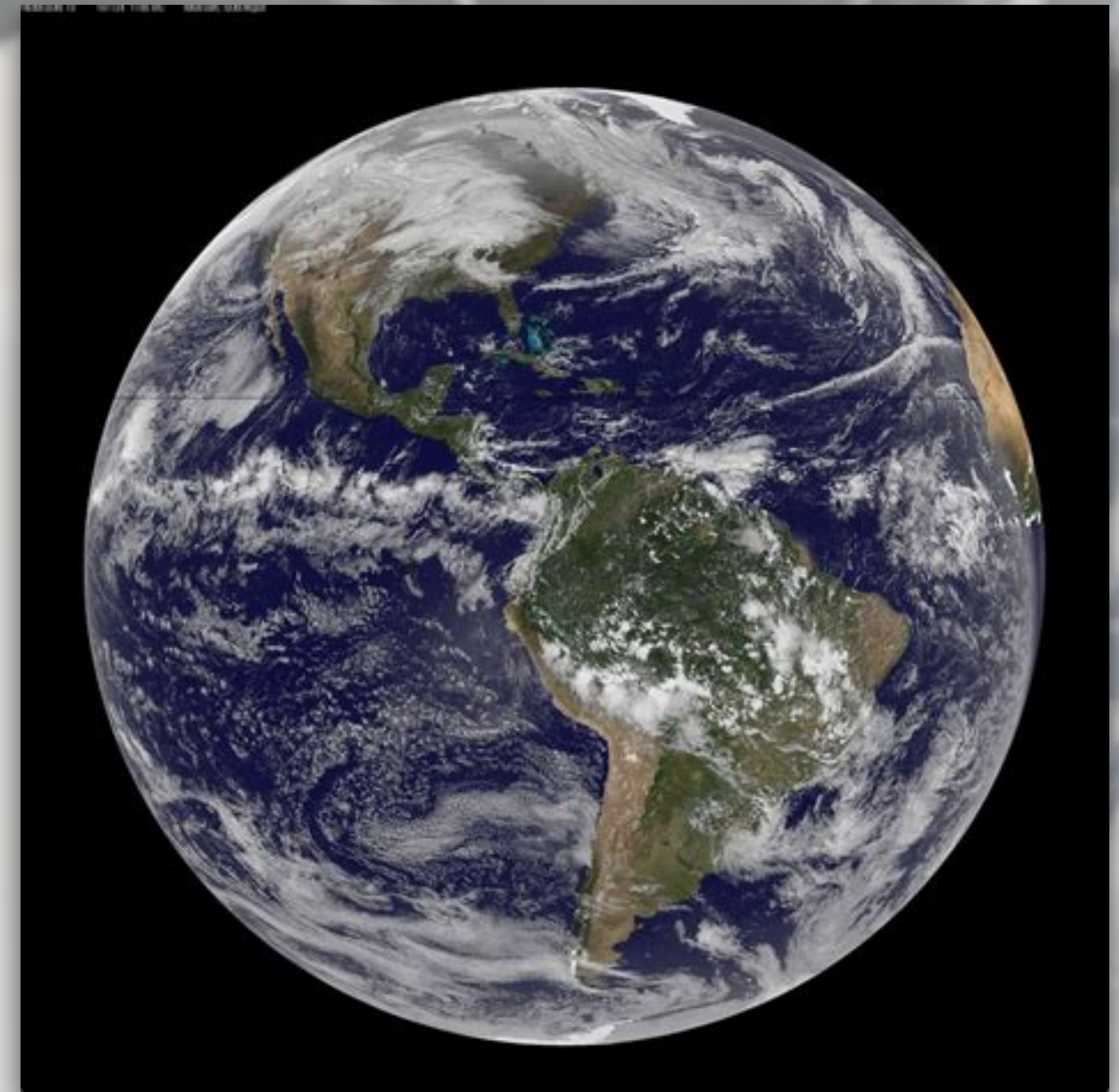

God is our Creator

- **Genesis 1:1** “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
- **Genesis 2:4** This [is] the history of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens



Listen and Obey to all God's Commands

- **Ecclesiastes 12:13-14** Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all. For God will bring every work into judgement, Including every secret thing, Whether good or evil.



God is more Important than Family

- **Luke 12:51-53** "Do [you] suppose that I came to give peace on earth? I tell you, not at all, but rather division. 52 "For from now on five in one house will be divided: three against two, and two against three. 53 "Father will be divided against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against her daughter-in-law and daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law."

- **Genesis 2:23-24** And Adam said: "This [is] now bone of my bones And flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, Because she was taken out of Man." 24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.



God sets the Standard for Modesty



Cover and
Conceal

Modesty: Involves two parts: the inward and outward. The inward person must be of good character, of Godliness, and purity. And by such, what is presented outwardly actions / behavior & covering/concealing our nakedness will show who we belong to.

God demands Abstinence from Alcohol

- **1 Peter 1:13** Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest [your] hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;
- **1 Peter 5:8** Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.



God wants you to be Peculiar

- **1 Peter 4:3-4** For we [have spent] enough of our past lifetime in doing the will of the Gentiles--when we walked in lewdness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries. 4 In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with [them] in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of [you].

- **2 Peter 3:3-6** “knowing this first: that scoffers will come in the last days, walking according to their own lusts, 4 and saying, “Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as [they were] from the beginning of creation.” 5 For this they willfully forget: that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water, 6 by which the world [that] then existed perished, being flooded with water.”

- **Psalm 104:6-9** “You covered it with the deep as [with] a garment; The waters stood above the mountains. 7 At Your rebuke they fled; At the voice of Your thunder they hastened away. 8 They went up over the mountains; They went down into the valleys, To the place which You founded for them. 9 You have set a boundary that they may not pass over, That they may not return to cover the earth.”

All Sin Separates us from God

- **Proverbs 6:16-19** “These six [things] the LORD hates, Yes, seven [are] an abomination to Him: 17 A proud look, A lying tongue, Hands that shed innocent blood, 18 A heart that devises wicked plans, Feet that are swift in running to evil, 19 A false witness [who] speaks lies, And one who sows discord among brethren.”
- **1 John 3:4** “Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness.”



All Sin Separates us from God

- **Isaiah 59:1-2** “Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, That it cannot save; Nor His ear heavy, That it cannot hear. 2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden [His] face from you, So that He will not hear.”
- **Romans 6:23** “For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Lewdness is Wrong

- 23 times in the Bible
 - 8 Times in the NT
- **1 Peter 4:3** “For we *have spent* enough of our past lifetime in doing the will of the Gentiles—when we walked in lewdness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries.”



Lewdness is Wrong

- dictionary.com defines it as indecency or obscenity; vulgar sexual character or behavior
- Thayers: unbridled lust, excess, licentiousness, lasciviousness, wantonness, outrageousness, shamelessness, insolence... wanton (acts or) manners, as filthy words, indecent bodily movements, unchaste handling of males and females, etc



Lewdness is Wrong

- **Galatians 5:19-21** “Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, 20 idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, 21 envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told [you] in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.”

Evil Companions corrupt Good Morals

- **1 Corinthians 15:33** “Do not be deceived: “Bad company corrupts good morals.” (NASB)
- **Proverbs 1:15-16** “My son, do not walk in the way with them, Keep your foot from their path; 16 For their feet run to evil, And they make haste to shed blood.”

Jesus conquers cancel culture

- **Psalm 22:6** “But I [am] a worm, and no man; A reproach of men, and despised by the people.”
- **Psalm 22:7** “All those who see Me ridicule Me; They shoot out the lip, they shake the head, [saying],”



Jesus conquers cancel culture

- **Isaiah 53:3** “He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, [our] faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.”
- **John 1:11** “He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.
- **John 15:18** “If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before *it hated* you.”


