Micah 5:2 (NKJV)

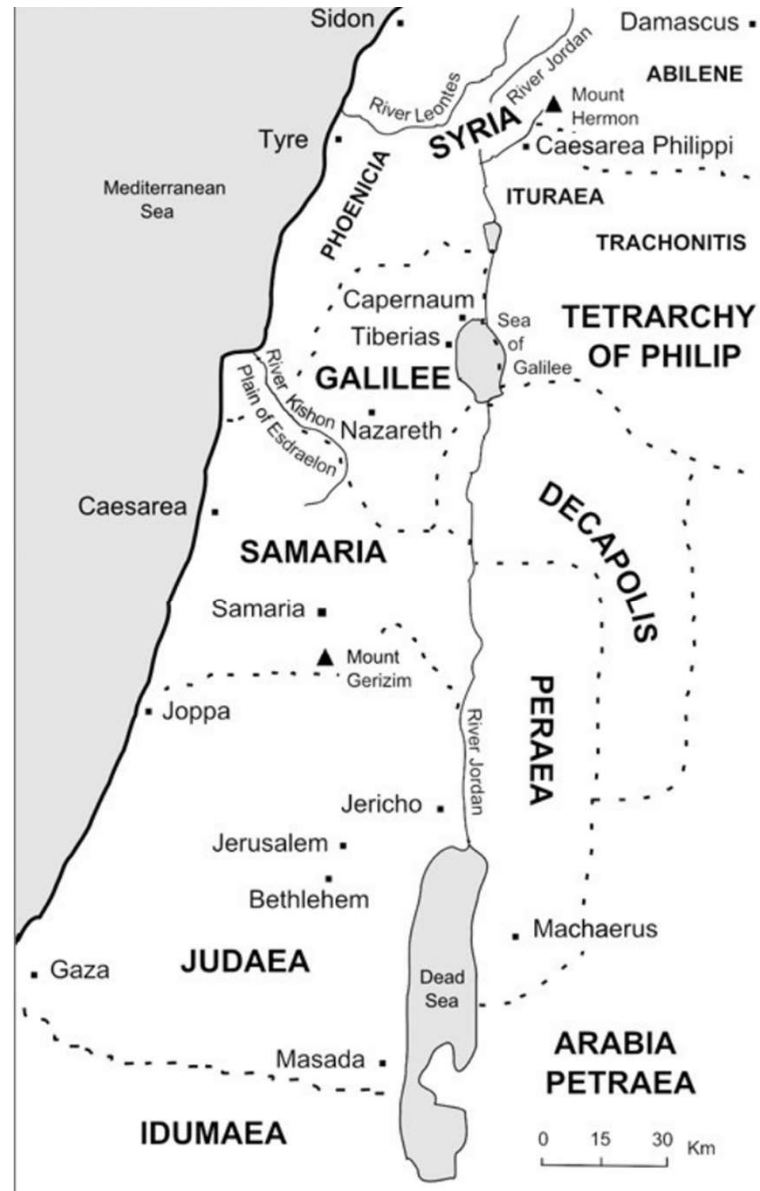
