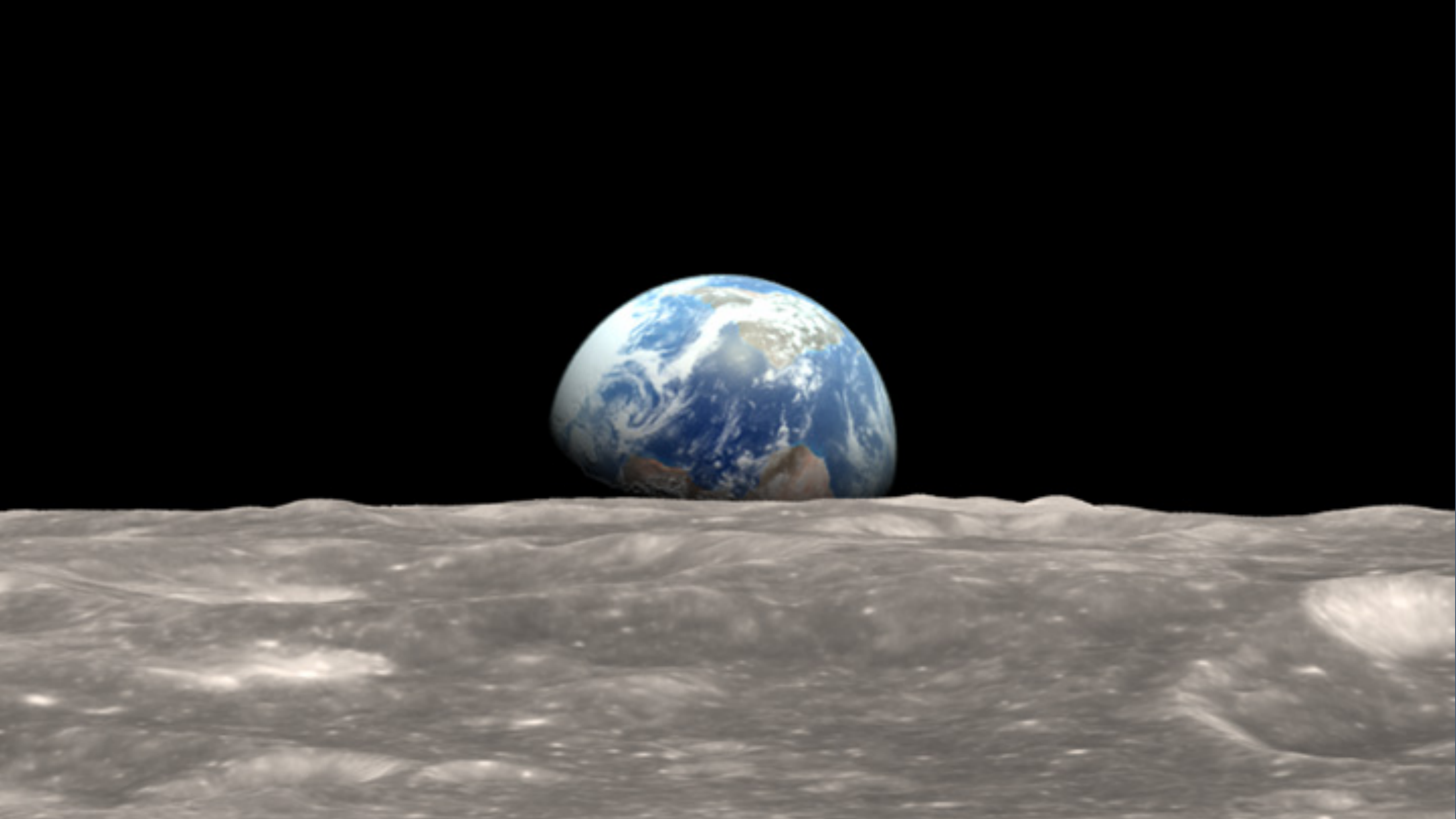




Psalm 8:1-4, 9

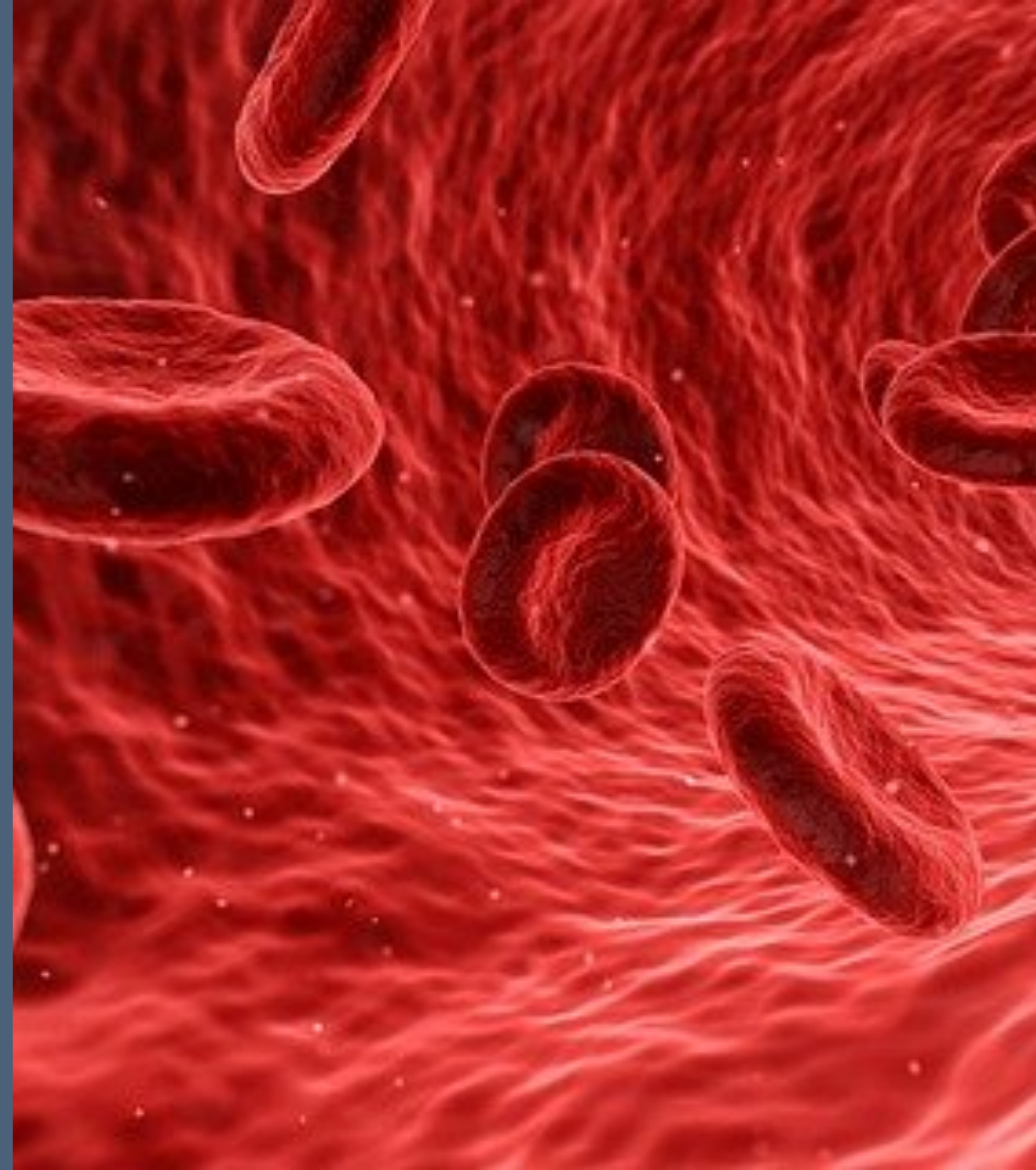

Blood is the Liquid of Life

Leviticus 17:11-14 "For the life of the flesh [is] in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it [is] the blood [that] makes atonement for the soul.' 12 "Therefore I said to the children of Israel, 'No one among you shall eat blood, nor shall any stranger who dwells among you eat blood.' 13 "Whatever man of the children of Israel, or of the strangers who dwell among you, who hunts and catches any animal or bird that may be eaten, he shall pour out its blood and cover it with dust; 14 "for [it is] the life of all flesh. Its blood sustains its life. Therefore I said to the children of Israel, 'You shall not eat the blood of any flesh, for the life of all flesh is its blood. Whoever eats it shall be cut off.'"



Blood is the Liquid of Life

- This statement is made by Moses around 1,450 BC
- Versus bloodletting from the Middle Ages through the 19th Century
- President George Washington
- Hemoglobin in the red blood cells that carries oxygen to the brain
 - “Red blood cells carry approximately 270,000,000 molecules of hemoglobin per cell. If there were any less, there would not be enough residual oxygen to sustain life after, say, a hard sneeze or a hefty pat on the back.”

Deuteronomy 23:12-13 “Also you shall have a place outside the camp, where you may go out; 13 “and you shall have an implement among your equipment, and when you sit down outside, you shall dig with it and turn and cover your refuse.”

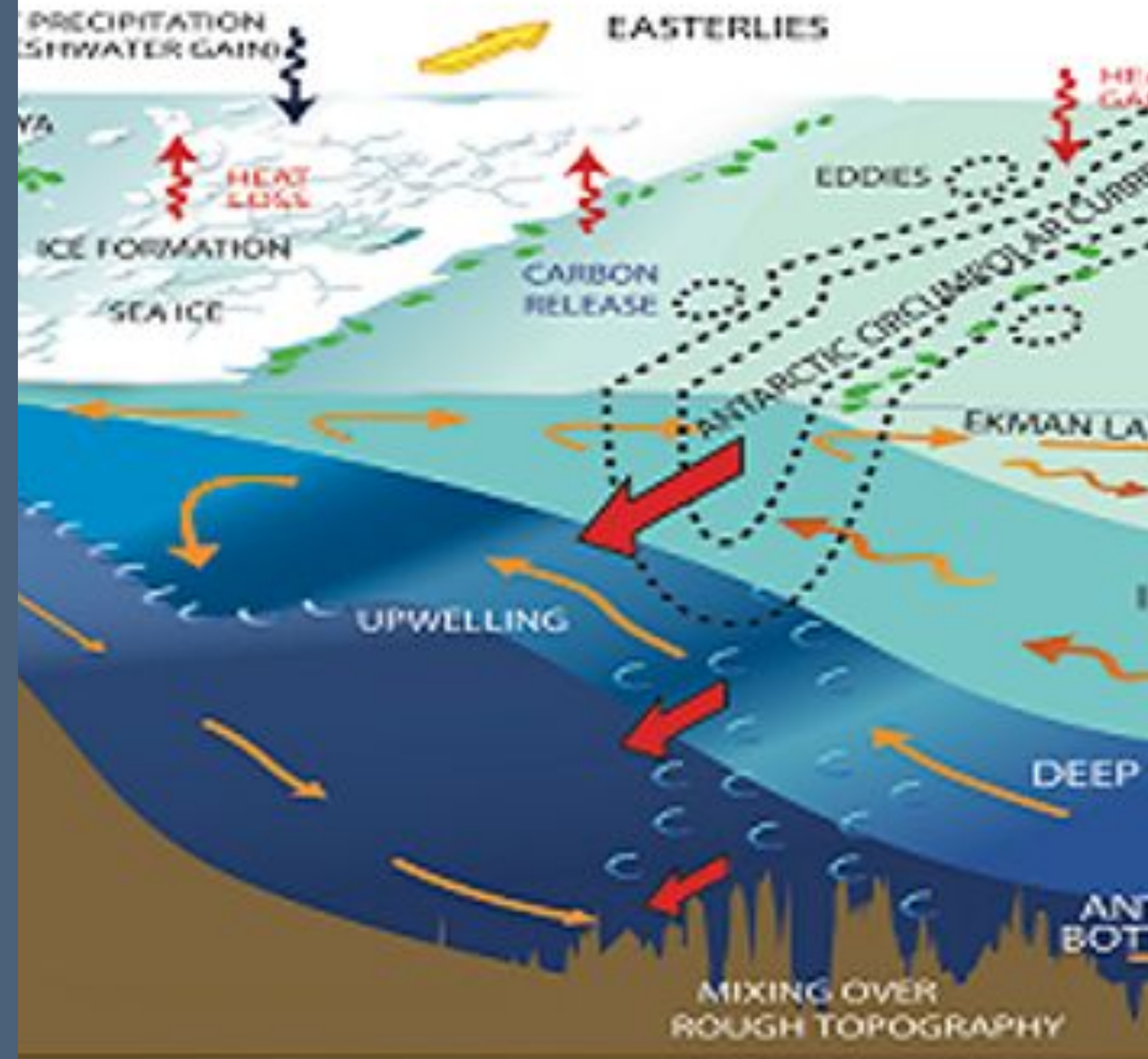


Oceanography

Psalm 8:8 “The birds of the air, And the fish of the sea That pass through the paths of the seas.”

Solar System Design

Solar System Design

Stuart Clark, of New Scientist magazine, “How come Earth got all the good stuff?”

- We know that its distance from the sun provides the right amount of heat and light to make the planet habitable, but that alone is not enough. Without the unique mix of carbon, hydrogen, nitrogen, oxygen, phosphorus and sulphur that makes up living things, and without liquid water on the planet’s surface, life as we know it could not have evolved. Chemically speaking, Earth is simply better set up for life than its neighbors. So how come we got all the good stuff? (p. 29)

Solar System Design

Just how precise is the Earth's location?

- If the average distance from the Sun was “reduced by only about three-tenths of a percent,” disastrous atmospheric changes would occur, including “sea-level rise, increases in extreme weather, species extinctions and agricultural disruptions.

Solar System Design

Just how precise is the Earth's location?

- As it (earth) makes its elliptical path around the Sun, the Earth bends from its straight course "only one ninth of an inch" every $18\frac{1}{2}$ miles. "If the orbit changed by one-tenth of an inch every 18 miles, our orbit would be vastly larger and we would all freeze to death. One-eighth of an inch?
