- A devouring fire/everlasting burnings (Isaiah 33:14)
- A furnace of fire (Matthew 13:41,42)
- A place of wailing and gnashing of teeth (Matthew 13:41,42)
- A place of everlasting punishment (Matthew 25:46)
- A place of blackness of darkness forever (Jude 3)
- A place prepared for the Devil and his angels (Matthew 25:41)
- A place from which the smoke of their torment ascends up forever (Rev 14:11)
- A place where there is no rest (Revelation 14:11)
- A place you do not want your loved ones to come (Luke 16:28)
- A place full of wicked people (Revelation 21:8)
- A place of separation from God (II Thessalonians 1:7-9)
