Exodus 35:4-5, 21, 29 And Moses spoke to all the congregation of the children of Israel, saying, "This [is] the thing which the LORD commanded, saying: 5 'Take from among you an offering to the LORD. Whoever [is] of a willing heart, let him bring it as an offering to the LORD: gold, silver, and bronze; ... 21 Then everyone came whose heart was stirred, and everyone whose spirit was willing, [and] they brought the LORD's offering for the work of the tabernacle of meeting, for all its service, and for the holy garments. ... 29 The children of Israel brought a freewill offering to the LORD, all the men and women whose hearts were willing to bring [material] for all kinds of work which the LORD, by the hand of Moses, had commanded to be done.

Numbers 18:21-26 "Behold, I have given the children of Levi all the tithes in Israel as an inheritance in return for the work which they perform, the work of the tabernacle of meeting. 22 "Hereafter the children of Israel shall not come near the tabernacle of meeting, lest they bear sin and die. 23 "But the Levites shall perform the work of the tabernacle of meeting, and they shall bear their iniquity; [it shall be] a statute forever, throughout your generations, that among the children of Israel they shall have no inheritance. 24 "For the tithes of the children of Israel, which they offer up [as] a heave offering to the LORD, I have given to the Levites as an inheritance; therefore I have said to them, 'Among the children of Israel they shall have no inheritance.' " 25 Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, 26 "Speak thus to the Levites, and say to them: 'When you take from the children of Israel the tithes which I have given you from them as your inheritance, then you shall offer up a heave offering of it to the LORD, a tenth of the tithe.

Deuteronomy 12:5-7 "But you shall seek the place where the LORD your God chooses, out of all your tribes, to put His name for His dwelling place; and there you shall go. 6 "There you shall take your burnt offerings, your sacrifices, your tithes, the heave offerings of your hand, your vowed offerings, your freewill offerings, and the firstborn of your herds and flocks. 7 "And there you shall eat before the LORD your God, and you shall rejoice in all to which you have put your hand, you and your households, in which the LORD your God has blessed you.

Deuteronomy 14:28-29 "At the end of [every] third year you shall bring out the tithe of your produce of that year and store [it] up within your gates. 29 "And the Levite, because he has no portion nor inheritance with you, and the stranger and the fatherless and the widow who [are] within your gates, may come and eat and be satisfied, that the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hand which you do.

- Exodus 23:10-11: 7th required to leave the fields for the poor
- Deuteronomy 23:24-25; Luke 6:1: satisfying hunger
- Leviticus 19:9-10; Deuteronomy 24;19-22: learning the corners of the field
- Deuteronomy 15:1-4: 7th year debt relief, also called the Lord's release
- Malachi 3:8-10: God's cursing for those that didn't follow the commands on giving

- Luke 19:8 Then Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord, I give half of my goods to the poor; and if I have taken anything from anyone by false accusation, I restore fourfold."
- Luke 21:1-4 And He looked up and saw the rich putting their gifts into the treasury, 2 and He saw also a certain poor widow putting in two mites. 3 So He said, "Truly I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all; 4 "for all these out of their abundance have put in offerings for God, but she out of her poverty put in all the livelihood that she had."

- Matthew 23:23 "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have neglected the weightier [matters] of the law: justice and mercy and faith. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone.
- Acts 2:44-45 Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, 45 and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need.
- Acts 4:34-35 Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, 35 and laid [them] at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need.

- Acts 4:36-37: Barnabas sold his land
- Acts 11:27-30: The disciples in Antioch, each according to their ability, sent relief
- Romans 15:25-26; 2 Corinthians 8:1-5: Example of the churches in Macedonia and Achaia
- Philippians 1:3-5; 4:14-18: The brethren in Philippi helping Paul

- John 3:16: For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- 2 Corinthians 8:9: For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich.

Seek to Excel

- Matthew 5:20: For I say to you, that unless your righteousness exceeds [the righteousness] of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.

Do we look to excel or just to get by?

Do so Willingly

- 2 Corinthians 8:12: For if there is first a willing mind, [it is] accepted according to what one has, [and] not according to what he does not have.
- 2 Corinthians 9:5,7: Therefore I thought it necessary to exhort the brethren to go to you ahead of time, and prepare your generous gift beforehand, which [you had] previously promised, that it may be ready as [a matter of] generosity and not as a grudging obligation. ... 7 [So let] each one [give] as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

We must give because we want to, not because we have to

Understanding our Abundance

- 2 Corinthians 8:13: For [I do] not [mean] that others should be eased and you burdened;
- 2 Corinthians 8:14: but by an equality, [that] now at this time your abundance [may supply] their lack, that their abundance also may [supply] your lack--that there may be equality.
- 2 Corinthians 8:15: As it is written, "He who [gathered] much had nothing left over, and he who [gathered] little had no lack."

There is a focus on those that have an abundance to help those that lack

Sowing Bountifully

- 2 Corinthians 8:7: But as you abound in everything--in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us--[see] that you abound in this grace also.
- 2 Corinthians 9:6: But this [I say]: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.
- 2 Corinthians 9:8-10: And God [is] able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all [things], may have an abundance for every good work. 9 As it is written: "He has dispersed abroad, He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever." 10 Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have [sown] and increase the fruits of your righteousness,

Seek to give bountifully, that you might give even more

Give Purposely

Budget beforehand to give purposely and willingly

With Cheerfulness

• 2 Corinthians 9:7: [So let] each one [give] as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

If we cannot give cheerfully, then our giving is not acceptable to God!
