- The Bible claims to be inspired.
 - What does "inspired" mean?
 - Inspired like an artist or poet
 - God gave general ideas to the writers
 - Every word of the scriptures was given by God

"All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works."

- The Bible claims to be inspired.

 - Written by approximately 40 different writers
 - Different backgrounds
 - Different educations
 - Written over a period of over 1500 years
 - Written from different geographical locations
 - Written in different languages

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Why do we... Believe the Bible Is God's Word

- The Bible claims to be inspired.
- The *unity* and *harmony* of the Bible prove its inspiration.
- The flawless accuracy of the Bible proves its inspiration.
 - Historically accurate
 - Scientifically accurate

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- The flawless accuracy of the Bible proves its inspiration.
- The fulfilled prophecies of the Bible prove its inspiration.

- made by Ezekiel in 590 BC
 - ✓ Many nations would attack Tyre, the first by Babylon led by Nebuchadnezzar (Ezekiel 26:3-7)
 - √fulfilled 572 BC

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 - ✓ fulfilled 572 BC when the city's people and wealth slipped away to a nearby island

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 - ✓ The dust of the city was to be scraped, the area would be left like the "top of a rock"; also the ruins of the city would be cast into the sea (Ezekiel 26:4,12)

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 - ✓ fulfilled in 332 BC when Alexander's army used the ruins of the city to build a causeway to the island
