

- There are things that don't make for peace
 - False teaching (II Peter 2:1-3, Jude 18,19)
 - Anger (Proverbs 29:22, 15:18)
 - Hatred (Proverbs 10:12)
 - Pride (Proverbs 13:10, I Corinthians 12:12-15)
 - Gossip (Proverbs 26:20)
 - Quarrelsomeness (Proverbs 26:21)
 - Envy (James 3:14-16)
 - Factions (I Corinthians 11:18,19)
 - Loyalty to Man over God (I Corinthians 1:10-13, I Corinthians 4:6,7)
 - Carnality (I Corinthians 3:1-4)
